MC Dresser Saved Outfits:

*I use a separate save when saving the outfits, so I do not accidentally screw up any of my saves.

Step 1: Saving the outfits

- You need a male and female of each age group. I do 2 infants and 2 young adults to start
 - Age Categories:
 - Infant
 - Toddler
 - Child
 - Teens, Young Adults, Adults (All 3 ages share one outfit pool)
 - Elders
- Give them whatever outfits you want. Remember you can have up to 5 per category.
- In live mod:
 - Click the sim, MC Command Center
 - Click MC Dresser
 - Click Outfit Commands
 - Click Save Outfit
 - Change outfit, repeat
 - Age sims up if needed and repeat until you have as many outfits for each age category as you want.

Step 2: Limiting the NPC outfits

- On the computer click MC Command Center
- Click MC Dresser
- Ages to Run on Age-Up: Select All (or whatever ages you want)
- Outfit Settings Only Use Saved Outfits: Enable
- There are other settings here, but I don't usually use them. Click through and see if there's anything you'd like to change.

Step 3: Cleaning your save file

- Open your save file
- Click each of your sims that you don't want to change.
 - MC Command Center Sim Flags MC Dresser Flag Bypass Outfit Changes
- Once you have flagged any sims you want
 - Mailbox MC Cheats Sims/NPC Households Cheats MC Dresser Dresser Clean All Sims
- That should be it! If a random sim spawns without the outfits you want you can click on them - MC Command Center - MC Dresser - Outfit Commands - Clean Outfits
