Hang up your *Smile and Say Hello* poster near your door or meeting area. Take the time each day to smile and say hello to your colleagues, your students and their families.

Locate your Open Circle curriculum guide and schedule two 20 minute Open Circle periods into your weekly schedule. *K-5 teachers only*

Find your bulletin board. The first bulletin board will reflect the caring community you are building in your classroom.
