School Garden Maintenance Volunteer

<u>Groundwork Somerville</u> is a community-based, action-oriented non-profit. Our primary focus areas are youth development, food and farms, building a sustainable environment, and working for racial justice and health equity.

School Garden Maintenance Volunteers support the maintenance one or two Somerville Public School gardens. Hours are very flexible, with a minimum commitment of 1-2 hours per week. Training is provided. Additional volunteer opportunities are available to support garden events and cleanup days. This position requires a CORI background check through the Somerville Public Schools.

Commitment required:

- Minimum 1-2 hours per week
- Must commit to at least one season, with a preference of two consecutive seasons when possible. Seasons include:
 - Fall (September through November)
 - Spring (April through June)
 - Summer (mid- June -August)

Duties:

- Check on the garden at least once a week
- Perform general maintenance (includes watering, weeding, planting, and more under the guidance of Groundwork staff)
- Communicate with Groundwork staff about garden status, equipment needs, etc.

Qualifications:

- Good communication skills
- Basic gardening experience and knowledge is preferred, though not required
- Access to computer or smartphone to use online applications is very helpful, but not required
- Optional: Enjoys working with kids in the garden
- NOTE: CORI background check required; conducted by Somerville Public Schools

Benefits:

- Individual garden consultation and support from Groundwork staff
- Informal garden education and training
- This is a volunteer position. We regret that we cannot currently offer financial compensation. We are happy to certify volunteer hours, support receipt of college credit, and provide references for future employers.
