At CKHS, your course selections are extremely important. We use these selections to inform our decisions about course offerings. Our master schedule is built directly from the classes students choose during registration. We make every effort to meet first choice requests; however, the constraints of the schedule do not always make it possible. Therefore it is important to select alternate courses. Please take time to select courses you genuinely want to take and that align with your goals. Thoughtful planning helps us place you in the classes that best support your academic success and future plans. Review the expectations below carefully before submitting your final course requests.

Course Selection Expectations:

- Students must be enrolled in a full schedule. Students choosing fewer than 6 classes need parent, administrator, and/or counselor approval.
- You will be scheduled based on the courses you request during registration.
- Plan and register carefully — you are expected to remain in the classes you choose.
- Advanced/College-level, Honors, and year-long courses (AP, CIHS, etc.) require a year-long commitment. Students will not be removed from year-long classes at the semester.
- Schedule corrections are *not* made for teacher preference.
- Schedule corrections are only considered for misplacement or serious extenuating circumstances, and require approval from a parent, counselor, and administrator.
