



IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **SCHEDULE FOR LUNCH ON FRIDAY (NO ADVISORY):**

8.3 TARDIES – Board Policy 4.9

8.3.3 High School

Students should make a concerted effort to get to class on time. Students are considered tardy if they are not in their assigned places/location when the tardy bell rings. The first time a student is tardy to any class during a semester, he/she will be warned. When a student accumulates three (3) tardies, a phone call to the parent or guardian will be made. An assignment for one day of detention will be made for the fourth (4th) and fifth (5th) tardy, and the school social worker will make contact with the parent or guardian. For the sixth (6th) and seventh (7th) tardy, two days of detention will be assigned, and services will be provided by the school counselor. A student's absence progresses from a tardy to an absence if the student misses more than 15 minutes of instruction during the period. Upon the assignment to detention, parent notification of the detention will be mailed home and a phone call will be made to the parent's number on file in the office. On the eighth (8th) tardy and subsequent tardies, students will be assigned ISS. A FINS will be filed with the court when the student reaches eight (8) tardies in the AM.
