- 6. Topic Discussion (8:30 8:55 p.m.)
 - a. J. Lee Burke proposal by Daniel Miller
 - i. Tabled discussion for a later meeting
 - b. The Pinnacle proposal by Mike Napolitano
 - i. Questions
 - 1. What is the problem this program is trying to address?
 - 2. If a chapter falls behind, how are they motivated to continue to pursue this program?
 - 3. How will chapters submit evidence of attainment of each of the points of the program?
 - ii. Comments
 - 1. Diversity should be more than an item checked off on a checklist
 - Chapters are operating in a different space right now due to COVID that makes this program seem like not the most vital necessity at the current moment
 - 3. <u>If publicized well</u>, this program could be incredibly beneficial (seems like more of an actual award than just paperwork)
 - 4. Districts that have similar programs to this should be utilized as resources by the National Council (friendly competition is a legitimate incentive, particularly for disengaged chapters)
 - 5. Pushes chapters to better themselves through more equitable chapter programming (much success in the SED)
 - Concerns about tight timeline if this program is rolled out ASAP (particularly this year where many chapters are not near "The Pinnacle" right now)
 - a. Concern about how Founder's Circle roll out will work in conjunction with this program
 - b. It might be worth waiting until Nat Con to roll out
 - 7. It could encourage chapters to approach programming more creatively
 - 8. May be emotionally and logistically straining on chapters without enough time to become comfortable with our "new normal"
 - 9. 2 of the 5 points of the pinnacle (service and music) are not possible at many of our chapters currently
