As far as possible, the methods and techniques used should be specified by references, unless they are unusual or novel methods. The methods of statistical analysis used in the research must be specified as well as the programs used (software).

The writing should be in chronological form, so that any researcher can repeat these techniques. References, tables and diagrams can be made. Equations must be written using Word's equation editor. Decimal numbers will be indicated with commas if the original language of the manuscript is Spanish or Portuguese, and with periods if the original language of the manuscript is English.

Results and discussion

Include the description of the results and as tables or figures are mentioned, they are placed in the corresponding place. In addition, the discussion of the results with the use of bibliographic references and the contribution of researchers.

The results should be analyzed based on previous research and related to mechanisms and processes specific to the study area, supported by a review of cited literature. It is important to end this section with a paragraph reflecting the practical or theoretical implications of the research.

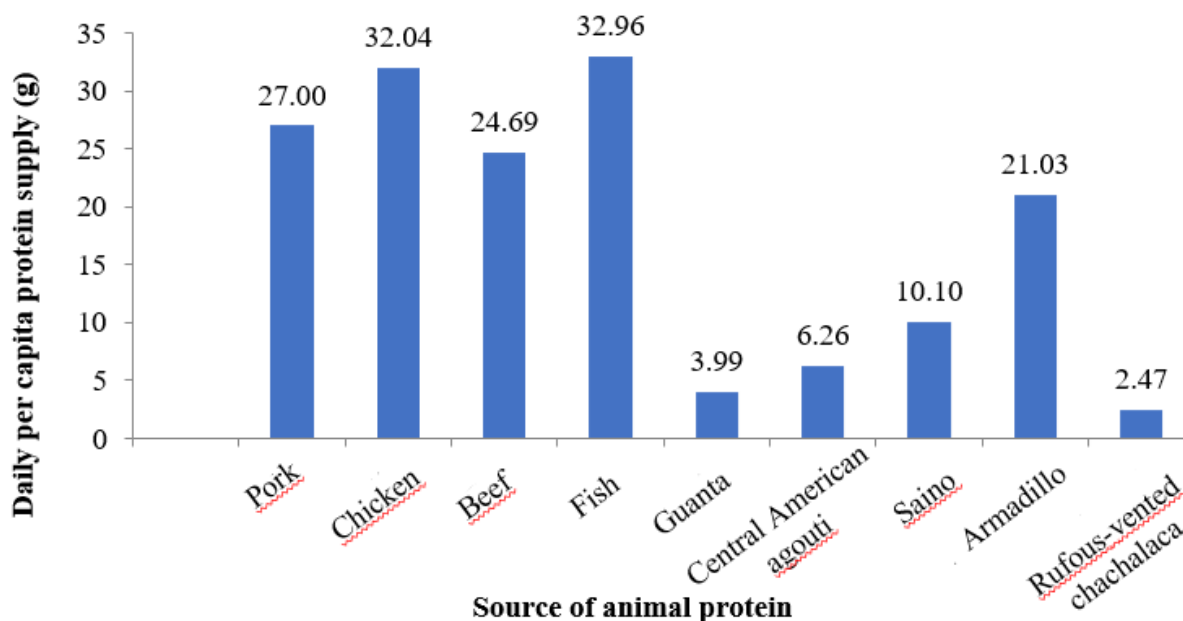


Figure 1. Sources of protein in the diet of the population of Flavio Alfaro and surrounding localities, Manabí, Ecuador.
