



## Oakland-Craig Public Schools Return to School Plan 2020-2021



The purpose of this document is to provide a framework for how Oakland-Craig Public Schools will respond to the COVID-19 pandemic and its impact on our educational program during the 2020-2021 school year.

The safety of our students and staff is our top priority while giving special attention to the importance of maintaining face-to-face education in our facility.

The Elkhorn Logan Valley Health Department will be using a risk dial for our county/ school district to inform us on how to respond to the changing public health circumstances.

The Risk dial is color coded with Green being low/stable risk, Yellow a moderate risk, Orange a elevated risk and Red a high or severe risk.

Burt County is listed as high/severe risk for the week of November 9th.
