What will distinguish your upcoming term as a member of the community college board from prior terms and board members? *

I believe City College should always be free for San Franciscans.

What do you think the problems are with the board and with City College? How would you address them? *

I believe many decisions made don't often benefit the student. But instead of focusing on cuts, we need to streamline the process for City College to transfer students to a university or provide the skills to work a meaningful life in the city. Invest in academic advisers to guide students on how to finish this chapter of their life in due time.

What are your thoughts on the SF WERCS (CCSF funding) ballot measure, and will you support or oppose it? Will you be actively involved in your support/opposition? *

Where else would I get the investment funding to run a college? I'll be active, otherwise I won't have the adequate funds to rejuvenate community education in San Francisco.

What programs will you prioritize to assure that CCSF continues to serve the community? *

Academic advisers to help students use City College as a stepping stone to the rest of their life.
