# Fall Semester Exams 2024

Fall 2024 exams: All students are expected to be in attendance on the days they are scheduled for an exam. If a student is absent and must miss taking an exam, the student must schedule a make-up exam with the teacher. Failure to attend the exam represents a forfeiture of any exam exemption a student may otherwise have earned. Missed exams must be made up by January 10, 2024, to be included in the next GPA calculation.

#### EXEMPTIONS FROM SEMESTER EXAMS: GRADE LEVEL ELIGIBILITY

For exemption purposes only, **three tardies** to any class count as an absence to **every class** no matter where they occur across the schedule.

Any classes where an exemption is taken in the fall semester are ineligible to be exempted again in the spring semester. Plan ahead!

<u>Students in 9th-11th grades</u> may be exempt from up to three non-end-of-course-tested subject exams per semester for classes in which they meet the following guidelines:

- students must have a semester average of 85 or above,
- have no more than two absences that semester from that class,
- and are present on the exam day.

Students will be required to take first-semester exams in the fall in all EOC subjects; however, they will not be required to take a spring semester exam in EOC subjects.

Students in 12th grade may be exempt from three semester exams for classes in which they

- have a semester average of 85 or above,
- have no more than two absences that semester from that class,
- and are present on the exam day.

**Seniors and juniors** may have up to four absences when two of those absences are the absences allowed for visiting colleges and universities. Only two days for college visits are allowed per school year.
