The Celebration of Identities Dinner was well-attended. The vigil was organized by Micah Walker and other members of the Division of Educational Leadership. - 8. What are ways to create connections between committees and Faculty Senate Executive Committee (FSEC)? One suggestion was rather than electing FSEC members, Faculty Senate Committee Chairs could serve on FSEC. Another was that FSEC members could serve on committees.
