- 1. Tipping opens monthly for cases pending judgment in the High Court and closes for any particular case on the day the decision is handed down.
- 2. Competitors may comment with their tip as to which party will succeed. A competitor is any person who comments with a tip on any case in the competition.
- 3. Three points are awarded for a correct tip; one if a competitor does not tip; and zero for an incorrect tip. However, if a competitor marks a tip with a 'C', that tip is worth six points if it is correct; if it is incorrect, six points are subtracted from the competitor's score.
- 4. The competition ends after four rounds. The competitor with the highest aggregate score is the winner.
- 5. If a proceeding is discontinued, everybody gets one point.
- 6. It is a basic condition of the participating in this competition that it is intended and agreed that the conduct of the competition and everything done in connection therewith and all arrangements relating thereto (whether mentioned in these rules or to be implied) and this competition and any agreement or transaction entered into or payment made by or under it shall not be attended by or give rise to any legal relationship, rights, duties or consequences whatsoever or be legally enforceable or the subject of litigation, but such arrangements, agreements and transactions are binding in honour only.
