Preparing for this Meeting...

Reading:

- *Organic Outreach for Families* (Chapter 4) Reaching Extended Family
- *Organic Outreach for Families* (Chapter 2) Sharing Jesus with Your Children

Prayer: Pray that you would be responsive to every opportunity that God brings to share the Gospel and that you would have those opportunities on a regular basis.

Personal Action: Make a list of family members that do not have faith in Jesus. Include both close and extended family. Make a list of friends and people you see on a regular basis that have not come to faith. Now list neighbors who live near you who are separated from God. Focus on a couple of these people and decide how you can take steps to begin or increase relational connections. Come prepared to share about this and also prepare to share the Gospel message in 5 minutes or less at your Cluster group.

Meeting Agenda

Meeting Focus and Learning Theme: Every believer in Jesus is given people in their lives and relationships so that we can help others along on their journey of coming to know the Savior. It is important to recognize and pour into these relationships. It is just as important that we are equipped to share the hope that we have when the

opportunity comes. In this Organic Outreach Cluster Meeting, we will each share the Gospel message with our team members.

Opening Prayer:

- Pray that each of us would continue to pour into our current relationships with those who are far from God. Pray that we would be willing to establish new relationships as God brings, looking for natural ways to be able to share with them the reason for our hope in Jesus Christ.

Accountability

Three Minutes to Share It (The One-Degree Rule)

- What was your personal outreach temperature over the past month?
- Who is one person you are seeking to reach with the Gospel of Jesus?
- What is your ministry outreach temperature?
- What are you doing to raise your personal or ministry outreach temperature by one degree?

Inspiration

- Tell one outreach story from your personal outreach or ministry area.

Learning

Read: 1st Peter 3:15

Teaching Theme: Believers commonly will have people in their lives who are not of faith. God loves them and may want to work through your life to bring the truth of the Gospel.

Discussion:

- From your personal action list, name two people that you may reach out to that you haven't made much investment in yet. What steps will you take?

Group Interaction: If you are in relationship with those who have not yet come to faith, the time may come when they want to hear about your faith in Jesus. It is important that you are as prepared as possible when that time arrives.

- Each team member take five minutes or less to share the Gospel message as naturally and authentic as you are able using whichever gospel sharing method you choose. This can be done through your own personal knowledge, a phone app, a common presentation guide such as *Do vs. Done*, *The Bridge*, or any way that tells the Gospel message clearly.

Planning

Group discussion and collaboration

Give an update on your Ministry Action Plan and how it is working or how it may need to be revised.

What is coming up in your area of ministry in the next three to six months that is focused on outreach and how can people in your cluster support you and pray for you?

Closing Prayer: Pray Together...

- For continued relationships that help those who are not of faith move forward on their spiritual journey of coming to know Jesus.
- That God would give us each opportunities to share the Gospel message and that we would feel confident and prepared when the time comes.

Reading:

Prayer: Be in prayer that our light would shine from our lives, from our homes and from our church in ways that draws people to come to know Jesus.

Personal Action: Review your Goals & Actions list from last quarter. Make notes on what has been accomplished and the impact that is having as well as what hasn't been

accomplished, what has gotten in the way, and how barriers or roadblocks can be overcome.

Do the Organic Activities at the end of Chapter 8 of *Organic Outreach for Ordinary People*. Begin all four and continue even after your Organic Outreach One-on-One. Also ask yourself the question “when people outside of my home look at my family, in what ways do they see the presence and power of Jesus?” Come prepared to share at this month’s One-on-One Meeting.
