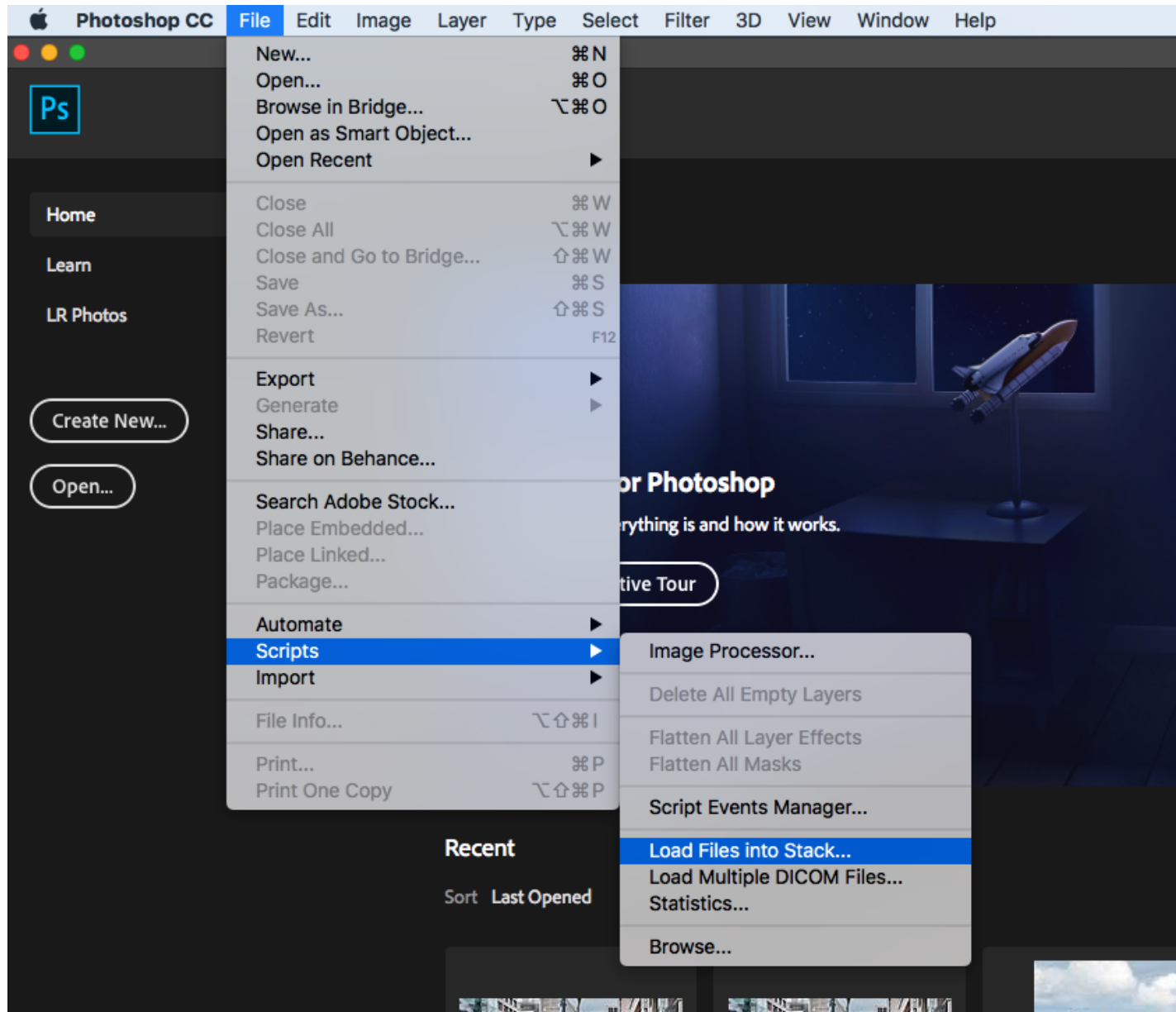
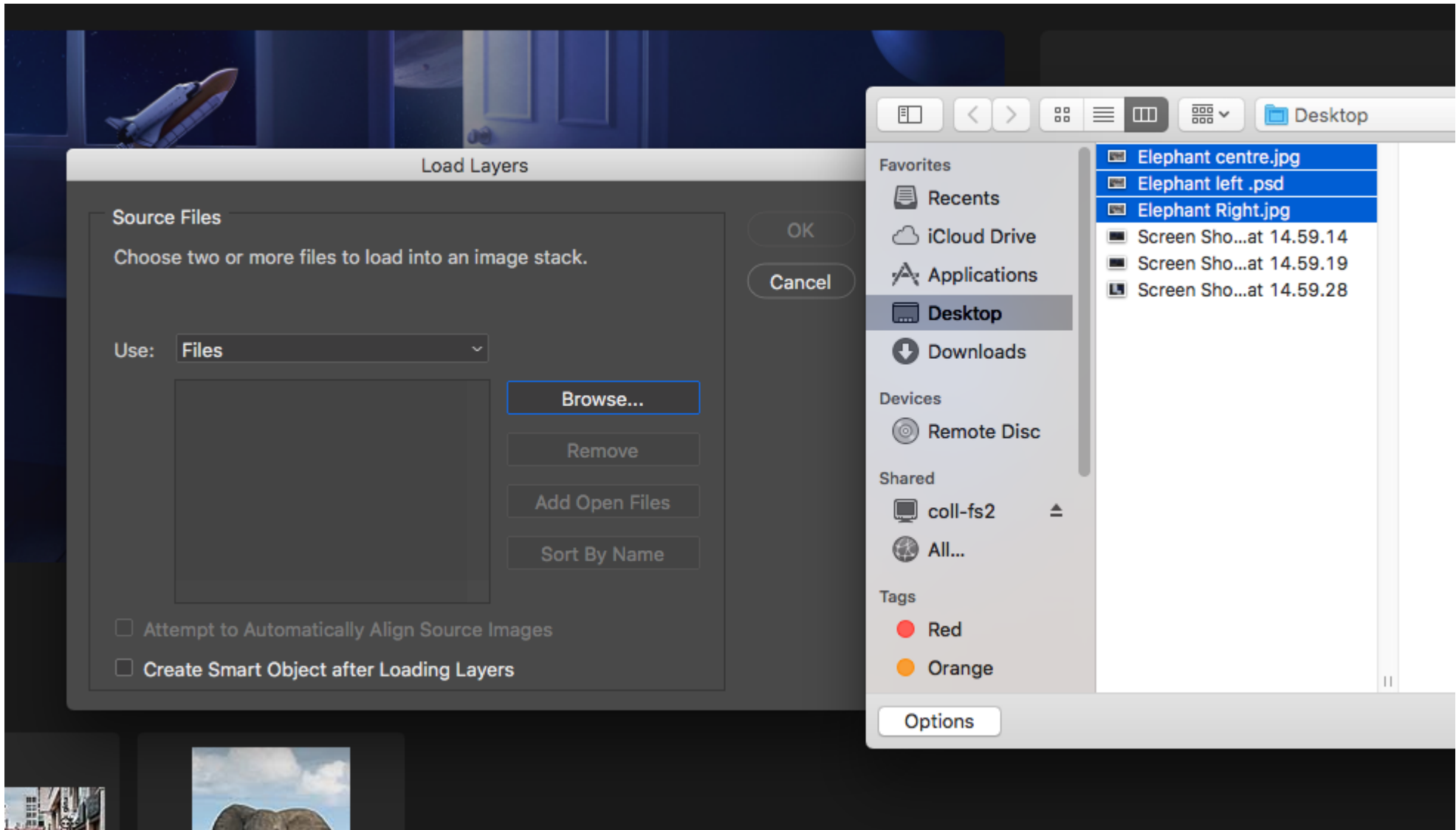


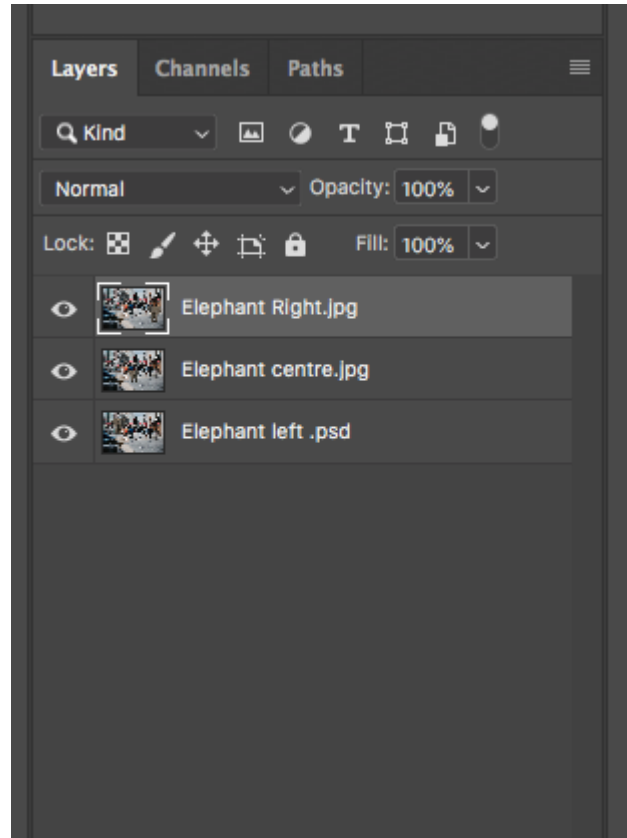
Multiplicty Guide

Import Photos this way...

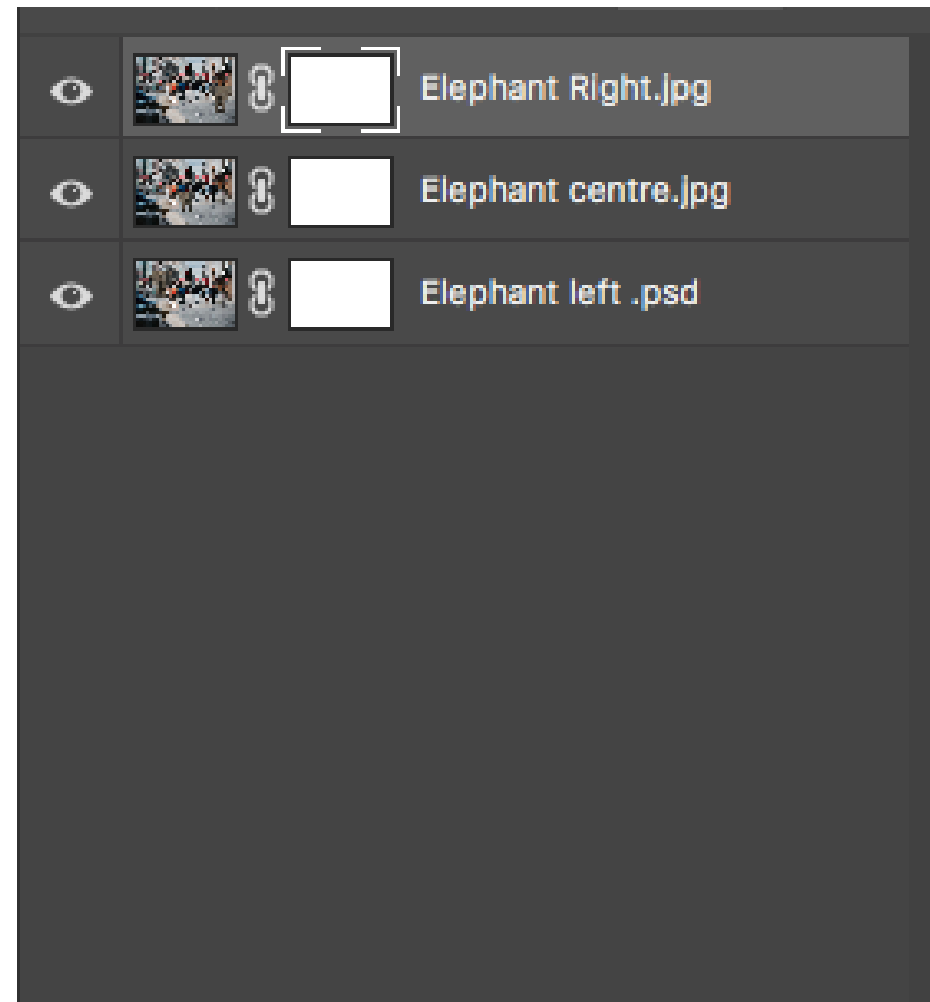
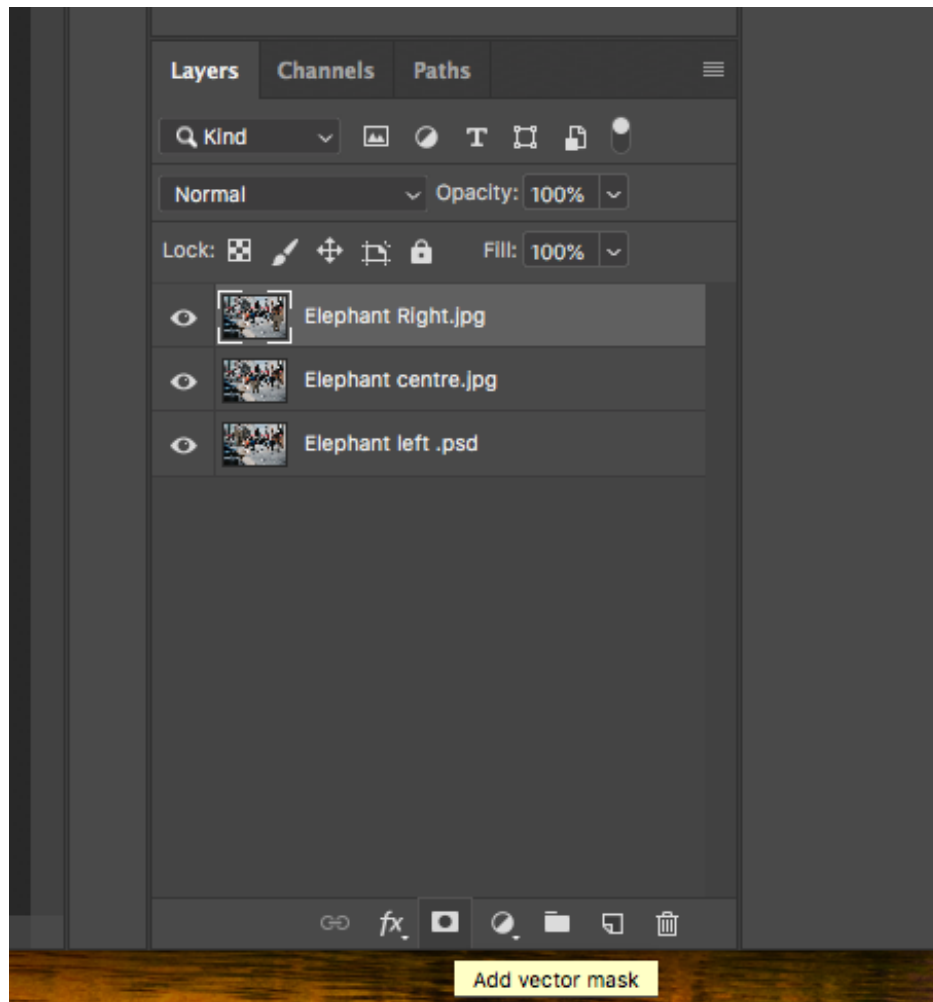




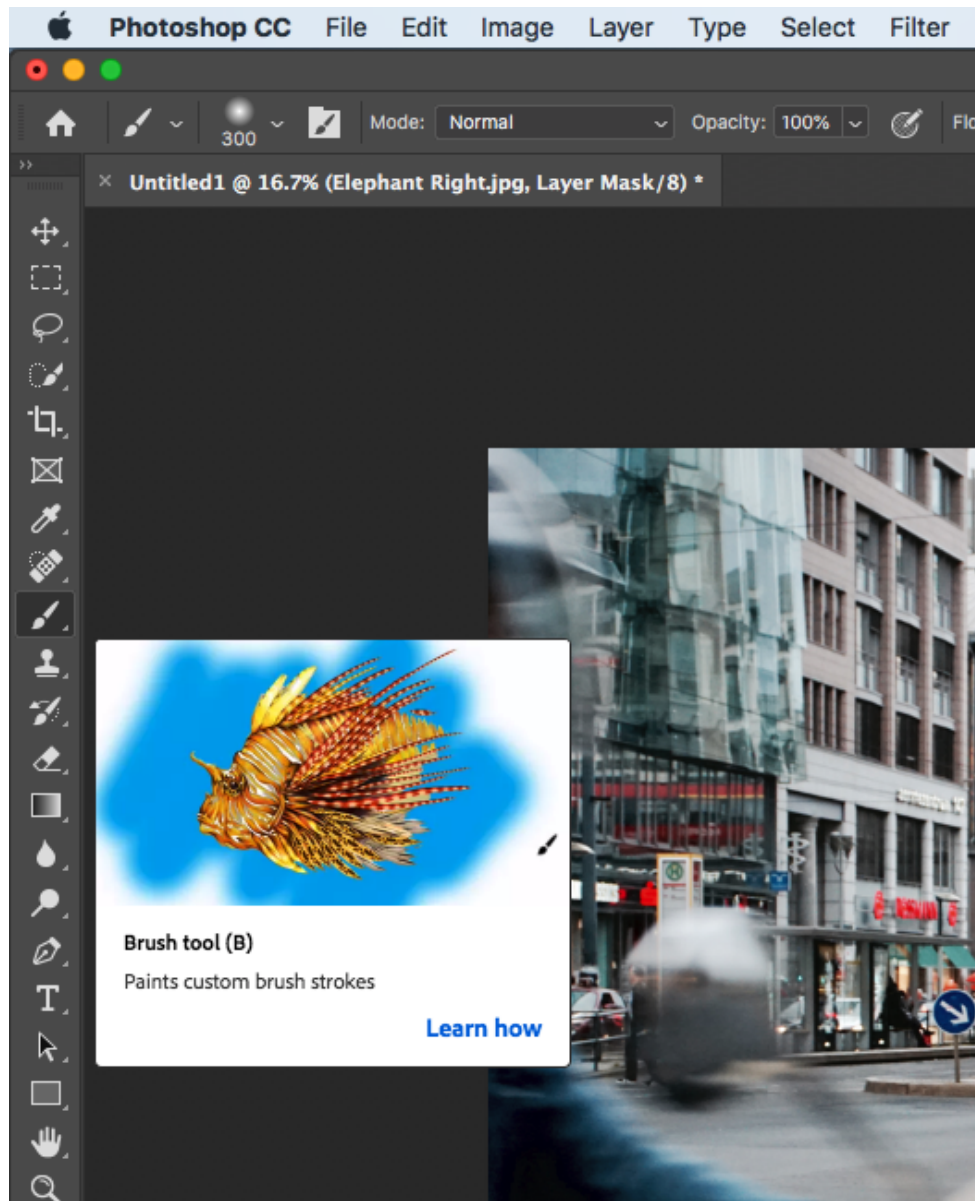
This will load all the photos in the same project, but on separate layers (bottom right)



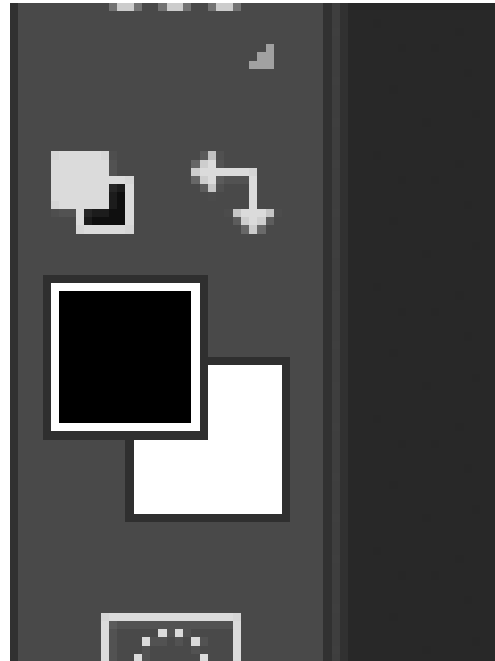
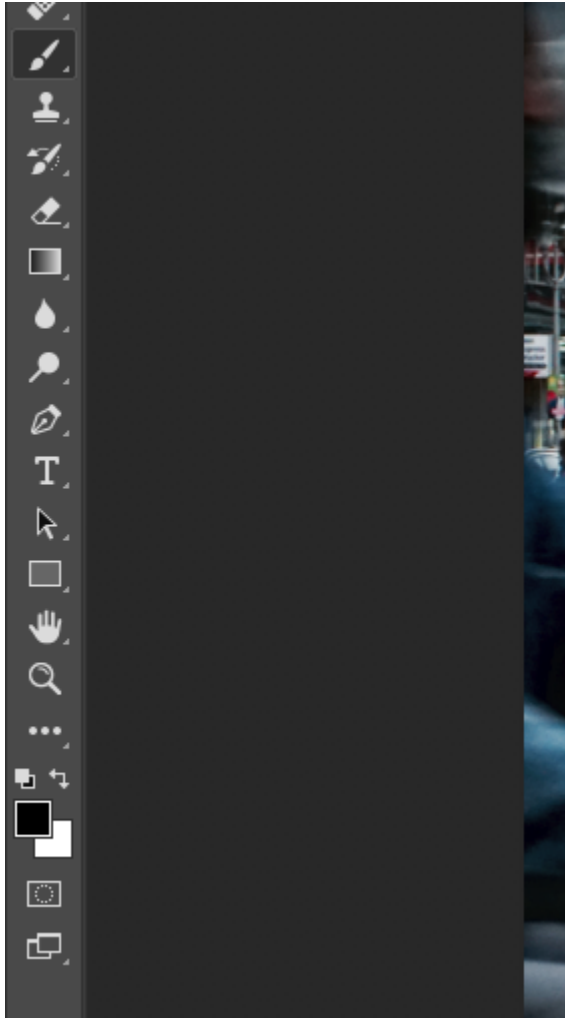
Add layer masks to every layer (bottom right)



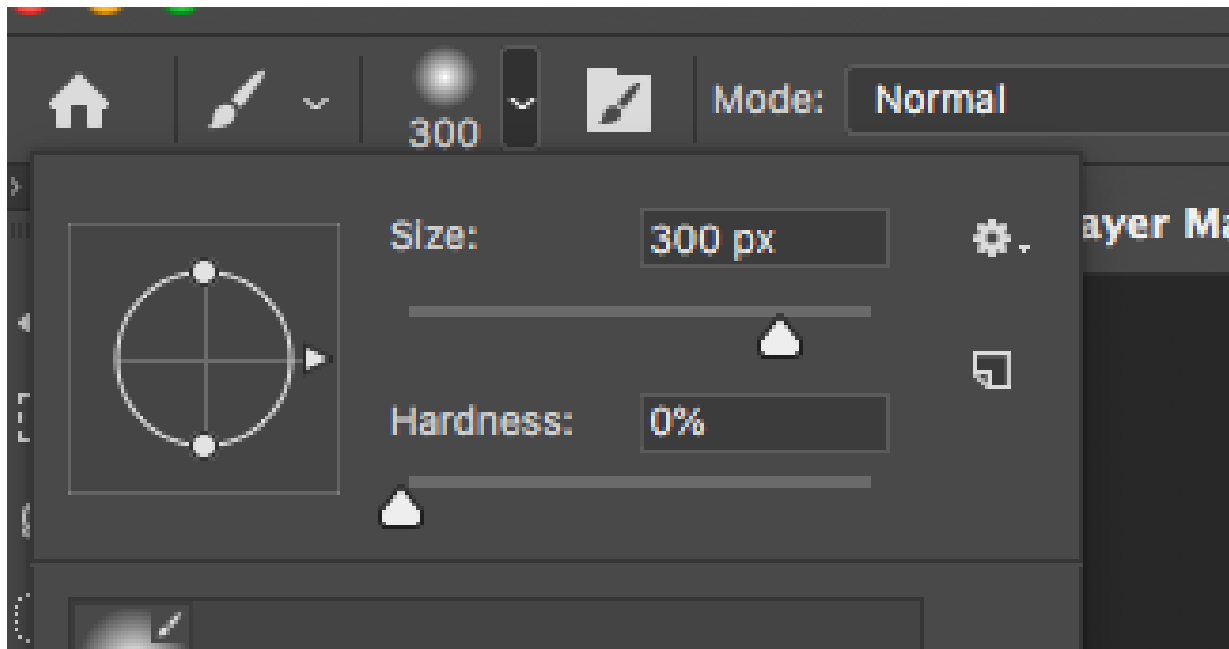
Use the brush tool (make sure it is the brush and not the pencil, if it is the pencil tool, long press the icon and select brush)



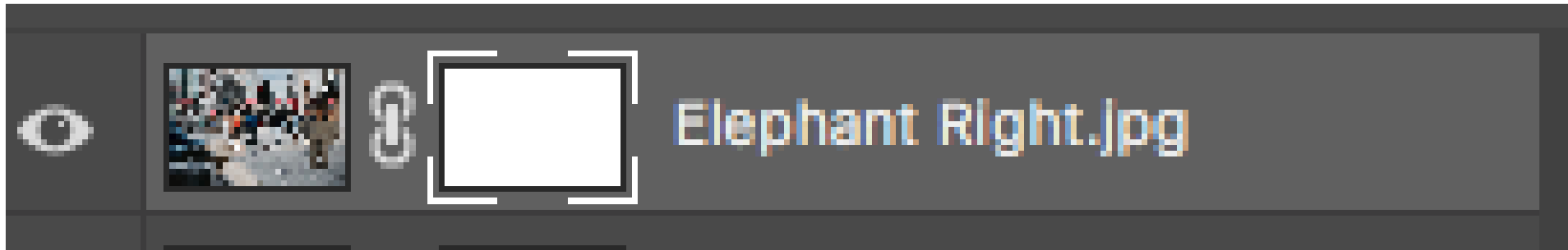
Make sure the brush is on black (on the left)



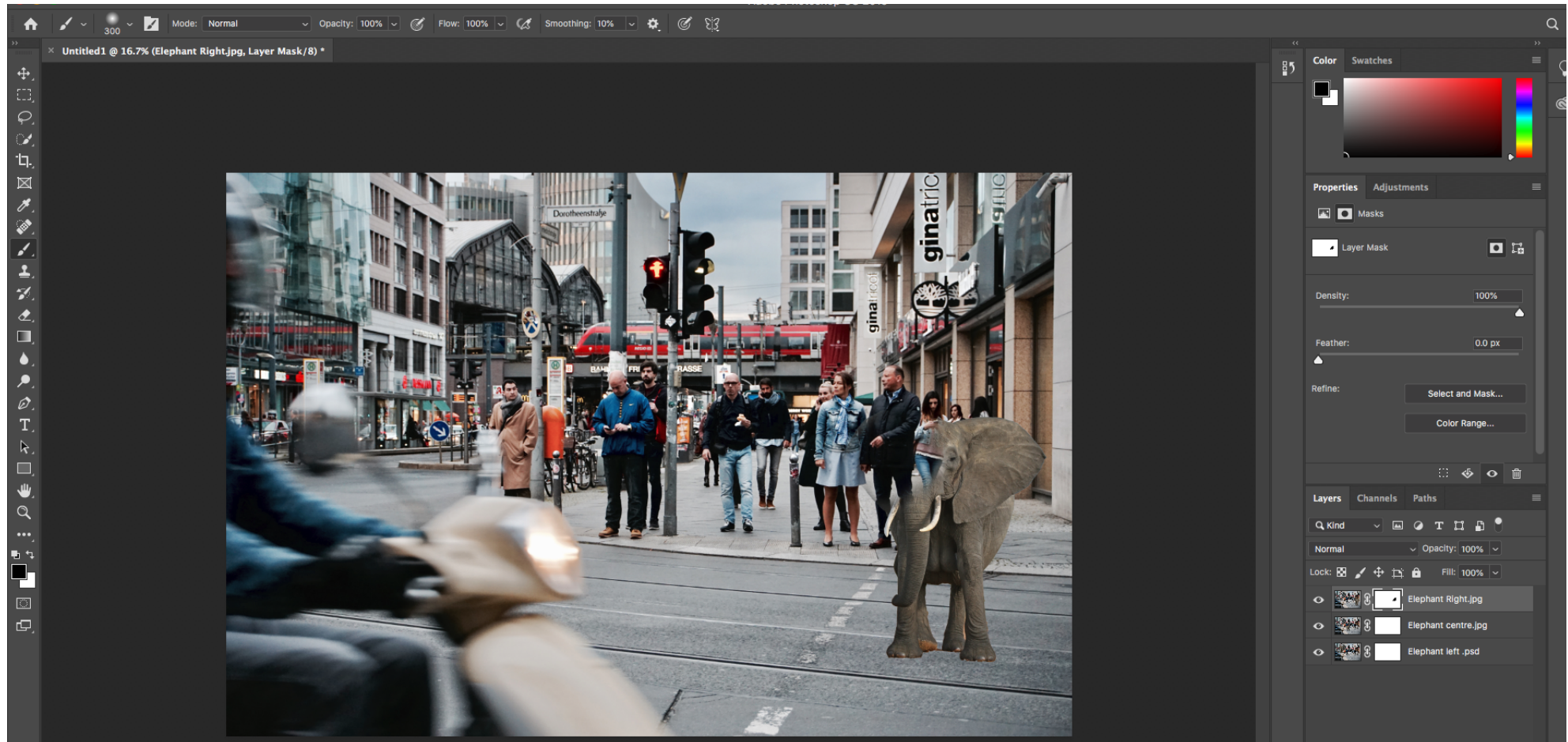
Make sure the brush is not hard (top left) and use the **[** and **]** buttons to make the brush bigger and smaller



Select the layer mask (bottom right)



Start painting out the person in the scene (they will appear later)



Until they are gone

Press cmd+I (windows logo+I) which should invert the image



The image behind should now appear!

Do this for every layer!
