# Countdown to Kindergarten Frequently Asked Questions

### When can I register my child for Kindergarten?

Kindergarten registration for the 2021-2022 school year opens Feb. 1 <a href="https://www.ucps.k12.nc.us/Page/2760">https://www.ucps.k12.nc.us/Page/2760</a>

### What do I need to register my child?

- -Your child's birth certificate to verify he or she will be five years old on or before Aug. 31. Birth certificates can be obtained from county officials in the county where your student was born.
- -A certified copy of your child's immunization record that includes a doctor's signature or a clinic's stamp as proof the vaccines were given.
- -Two documents that provide Proof of Residence from the following list:  $\cdot$  A notarized rental agreement or purchase agreement on a residence  $\cdot$  Utility bills (telephone, gas, electricity) that list the correct name and address  $\cdot$  A driver's license and automobile registration  $\cdot$  An automobile insurance policy  $\cdot$  A property insurance policy  $\cdot$  An income tax VV-2 form  $\cdot$  A property tax bill

### What is the age requirement for children to start kindergarten?

Children who will be five years old or before August 31, 2021 are eligible to be enrolled in kindergarten.

### What time does school begin and end?

Students can be dropped off at 7:00 a.m. The tardy bell rings at 7:30 a.m. Dismissal is at 2:00 p.m.

### How do I sign my child up to ride the bus?

On Scribbles under Registration Bus Rider Information please indicate if your child will need bus transportation for a.m., p.m. or both. Requests may take up to 2-3 weeks to be implemented.

## Will there be an assessment for kindergarteners at the beginning of the school year?

The first week of school, each kindergartener will only attend school for one day. During their first day, kindergarten teachers will administer the NC Early Learning Inventory (NC ELI). NC ELI is an observation-based formative assessment that includes a set of developmental progressions across the 5 domains of learning and development (language and literacy development, cognition and general knowledge, approaches toward learning, physical well-being and motor development, and social and emotional development).

### When will kindergarteners be assigned to their homeroom teachers?

Kindergarteners will be assigned a teacher at the end of the Staggered Enrollment Assessment Week. You will be notified by your child's teacher.

### What will my child learn in kindergarten?

Each day, kindergarteners will learn reading, writing, math, phonics, and cooperative play with other children.

### What special area classes are offered at Fairview?

### What health assessments and immunizations are required?

- Mandatory Health Assessment Requirements In order to comply with North Carolina GS 130A-440, each child entering public school, grades k-12 for the first time must have a health assessment completed by their Health Care Provider. The Provider may be out of state but the results of the physical exam must be recorded on a North Carolina Health Care Transmittal Form.
- The Health Assessment must not be done more than 12 calendar months prior to school entry and before the 30th calendar day after school entry and must also be completed on the NC Health Assessment Transmittal form.

#### **Immunizations**

North Carolina law requires all children in the state to receive certain immunizations. Records are checked when children enter school. Below are the requirements for Kindergarten.

Vaccine	Number Doses Required Before School Entry*
Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis	5 doses
Polio	4 doses
Measles	2 doses
Mumps	2 doses
Rubella	1 dose
Haemophilus Influenzae type B (Hib)	4 doses
Hepatitis B (Hep B)	3 doses
Varicella (chickenpox)	2 doses
Pneumococcal conjugate	4 doses
