

Title: size 14 Bold

Title should clearly and concisely convey the main issue of the research. And should be attention-grabbing and specify the scope of the research. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 14 Bold.

Author name: Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11 Bold (Right-aligned). Should specify Academic Title/Job Title, Affiliation (University/Organization), Country. Email of author in the Footnote Area If there are multiple authors, provide the information for each author separately, using the same format.

How to Add a Footnote and Author information:

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Abstract: size 11 Bold

Abstract should be summarize the key points of the entire research (objectives, methods, results, and conclusions). Should be independent of the main content of the article (understandable without reading the full content). Abstract should be in one paragraph. Write concisely and clearly words generally no more than 300 words. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11.

Keywords: Specify words or phrases related to the main issue of the research only 3 words

Introduction: size 11 Bold

Present an overview of the problem issue that the research aims to address. Explain the background and significance of the problem. Specify the objectives and scope of the research. Demonstrate the knowledge gap that this research aims to fill. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11.

Literature Review: size 11 Bold

Review research and theories related to the problem issue. Analyze and synthesize that research to demonstrate its connection to the current research. Demonstrate an understanding of the existing body of knowledge and the gap that this research aims to fill. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11.

Methodology: size 11 Bold

Explain the methods used to collect and analyze data. Specify the sample group, tools used, and procedures. Explain the reasons for choosing those methods. Demonstrate that the research process is reliable and verifiable. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11.

Results: size 11 Bold

Present the results of the data analysis systematically and clearly. Use tables, charts, or illustrations to help present the data. Explain the important and interesting results. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11.

Discussion: size 11 Bold

Analyze and interpret the research results. Compare the research results with related research. Explain the limitations of the research and suggestions for future research. Demonstrate how the research results answer the objectives that were set. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11.

Conclusion: size 11 Bold

Summarize the key points of the research and the results obtained. Emphasize the significance of the research and the potential impact. Demonstrate the contribution of the research. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11.

References: size 11 Bold

List all documents used in the references. Use accurate and consistent citation **APA Format**. Use Font 'Times New Roman' size 11.

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
