1. Definition of a Participant
 - i. Must be on Certified Academic Eligibility Roster
 - ii. Must be on Certified NWCA/OPC Weigh-In Roster
 - iii. Must be certified and eligible for specific weight class entered that weekend
 - iv. Individuals failing medical examinations/skin checks may be allowed to weigh in and then be listed on the bracket as a medical forfeit
 - v. Must make weight

J. The methods by which each district determines how to seed and draw, in addition to awarding or not awarding points after a bye in the championship bracket only, shall be determined by the participating colleges in that district.

Seeding Criteria

1. Head to Head
2. Common Opponent
3. Junior College Record
4. Overall Record
5. Returning All-American or National Qualifier same weight
6. Returning All-American or National Qualifier different weight
7. Coaches Vote
