Where: Monterey Bay Aquarium and Cannery Row, 886 Cannery Row, Monterey, CA 93940 **Make-up Work**: **Get make up work for your non-TEAM classes in Advance of the Trip!**

Why: This field trip has something to offer for all three TEAM academic classes. For Biology, students will be able to learn about the biodiversity of our oceans and how to protect them through our consumer choices. For English, students will be able to learn a bit more about John Steinbeck, one of America's most important authors. For History, students will be able to visit Cannery Row and see what it was like to be a worker during the early 1900's in coastal California.
