Scholarships for Women

College and university attendance for women is at an all-time high. According to the National Center for Education Statistics, there were about four women for every three men enrolled in college in the U.S. in 2018. And a 2020 report by the National Student Clearinghouse projected that there would be about three women for every two men enrolled in U.S. colleges in 2020. This demographic shift has been building for decades, and college scholarships for women are increasing to match the trend. Scholarships for women range from STEM to business to arts and humanities, as well as graduate studies and scholarships for women of color. Microsoft Cybersecurity Scholarship Program — Last Mile Education Fund

The US has a cybersecurity workforce shortage of nearly 500,000 trained professionals, yet only 3% of US students attain a credential in computer and information sciences and far fewer specialize in cybersecurity. The Last Mile Education Fund and Microsoft are working together to address the diversity and talent shortages in the cybersecurity workforce by investing in students like you. The Microsoft Cybersecurity Scholarship Program supports community college degree and industry certificate completion through emergency financial assistance (up to \$500) and subsidies for cybersecurity certification exam costs.

Philanthropic Educational Organization of women - Program of Continuing Education About the PEO Program for Continuing Education (PCE)

The P.E.O. Program for Continuing Education (PCE) is intended to provide one-time need based grants to women who are citizens or legal permanent residents of the United States or Canada for use in completing a degree or certification necessary for improving or gaining skills leading to employment.

The maximum grant is \$4,000.

Lesser amounts may be awarded based on funds available in the current year's grant budget and applicants' individual needs.

Grants will not be awarded for prerequisite courses or to those needing or choosing immediate continuation of their education beyond the current program for which the grant is requested.
