2026 STATE CONFERENCE INFORMATION

Dear Parents and Teachers,

Your student has earned the opportunity to attend the Nevada Thespian State Festival at Boulder City High School, March 4-7, 2026. The festival is a wonderful opportunity for your student to attend some amazing workshops and performances. Find information below, and if you would like your child to be a part of this opportunity, please sign the permission slip and return it with payment to your child's theatre teacher. Your child must register with their theatre teacher and or drama club advisor.

Nevada Thespians is a chapter of the International Thespian Society, a division of the Educational Theatre Association. The International Thespian Society is a non-profit, tax-exempt honorary organization for middle and high school theatre students. The society is committed to the advancement of educational theatre, and to this end, publishes *Dramatics* Magazine, sponsors Thespian Festivals and theatre workshops, produces educational materials, and provides college scholarship opportunities for students.

Who attends the Conference? Over 600 of Nevada's most dedicated theatre students in grades 6 to 12th grade.

When is the Conference? A detailed schedule will be provided the week of the conference

Wednesday, Mar. 4	4-10 PM	ONLY Opening number & STO candidate participants. (Northern schools opening# & STO can wait to come on Thursday if they wish)
Thursday, Mar. 5	4-9 PM	one-act performances, workshops & Honor Troupe presentations
Friday, March 6	9 AM-9 PM	mainstage, workshops, guest artist, performances, Tech Olympics, Thespys
Saturday, March 7	9 AM-7 PM	college auditions, scholarship auditions, mainstage, workshops, guest artist, performances, awards

Why should you attend? Students will have the opportunity to train with some of the Nation's leading professional teaching artists in Acting, Directing, Playwriting, and Technical Theatre. Students who qualified at the regional level will audition for the State Conference Showcase and compete for ITF scholarship money. Nevada Thespians will be awarding college scholarship

money; any current 12th-grade Thespian may apply. Troupes can apply for honor troupe status, and final rounds of Technical Theatre Olympics and One-Act Chapter Select will occur. The conference also affords students the opportunity to view theatre productions and main stage presentations, produced by other Nevada school theatre programs.

Some of the student opportunities and benefits are:

- Attend cool, exciting workshops
- Learn new acting techniques, technical theatre skills, and more
- Be entertained by Nationally Recognized Performers.
- Earn a Scholarship to attend the International Thespian Festival this summer for being a top performer.
- Earn a scholarship to attend the International Thespian Festival for participating in workshops!
- Seniors, apply for a Technical or Acting Scholarship to college
- Seniors, apply for the \$1000 Maureen Bernstein Memorial Education Scholarship for college
- Seniors, apply for the "Theatre for Life Scholarship" for college
- See amazing theatre from other schools in Nevada
- Run for a State Board position: Make decisions for the State of Nevada Thespians. Students must apply by the deadline date
- Compete to be named a Nevada Thespian Honor Troupe
- Meet College Reps and learn of other exciting programs

How much does the conference cost?

REGISTRATION AND FEES: **EVERYONE** attending this event **must be registered** (this includes parent chaperones). Registration allows entry to the entire campus, including all shows, events, workshops, Tech Olympics (for the qualifying schools from regional), and Thespys, as well as Friday lunch. All adults who are not currently in high school or employees of the school district will need to be fully registered AND complete a background check. (Background checks will be conducted every 2 years for attendees over the age of 18) **REGISTRATION IS OPEN, TEACHERS MUST REGISTER ALL STUDENTS. THE DEADLINE IS Friday, FEBRUARY 20**

- **\$75** per student.
- **FREE One Troupe Director** with 3 hours of assigned work assisting at the conference, includes Friday lunch. **At registration sign-in, troupe directors will be expected to sign up for a working room assignment.**
- **\$60** per **Chaperones/ Teachers other than the troupe director** includes Friday lunch
- **\$5** Tickets to the one-acts, guest artists, and main stage shows will be sold when seating is available for these performances. This is for non-registered parents, families. CASH ONLY PLEASE
- **FREE** Thespys (those auditioning for state showcase qualified as the top 15% from regional) - (all attendees must be registered)
- **No one except the registered ASSIGNED room supervisor, auditionees, and judges are allowed in the Thespy showcase or scholarship audition rooms. (no observers allowed)**
- Absolutely no audio or video taping is allowed in any of the auditions, workshops, or performances.

- **FREE** Tech Olympics; however, participants must register. The top 3 teams from each region are invited to compete for the overall State Tech Olympics awards. Only register if you were one of the top 3 teams in each region.
- There are no refunds or exchanges once registration is submitted

OTHER CHARGES

MEALS:

- Friday lunch tickets are included in your registration. But you **MUST** indicate how many of what type of lunch you need under “services.” **School is in session on Friday, so it will not be possible to order food “in” for lunch.**
- Meals will be available Friday evening and Saturday lunch for purchase.
- Participants in Opening Number will be asked to bring a “sack lunch” on Wednesday evening and Thursday lunch. Meals will be provided for dinner Thursday evening and Friday lunch.
- Board members, Sto, and Sto Candidates will be provided meals throughout the weekend.
- T-SHIRTS will be available first come first serve in the lobby for \$8.00.

ALL INDIVIDUALS MUST BE REGISTERED TO ATTEND OR PARTICIPATE IN ANY INDIVIDUAL EVENT, ONE-ACT, WORKSHOP, SHOW, OR ANY OTHER ACTIVITIES AT STATE.

The host school will provide snacks for purchase during the conference, with proceeds going toward the host school as a fundraiser. There are also several restaurants within walking distance in the area, and food will be available for purchase for Thursday/Friday dinner and Saturday lunch.

Is there supervision at the conference? YES! Each troupe director who has students attending is **required** to attend whenever their students are present or to provide a **registered chaperone** authorized by their administration to supervise their group. Nevada Thespians provides security in and around the conference location. **TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED**
