What we plan to do:

Some of our youngest children demonstrated that they did not understand the questions we were asking them. We will therefore look for different ways to seek their views in the future.

I am becoming an independent learner	'Learning Means the World' has been specifically designed to help us to help our children to develop the skills to become independent learners. The results tell us that our youngest children don't yet understand what this means. It will continue to be a focus of the work we do.
The work I do in class challenges me	It is clear that some of our children are not clear about whether the work they do challenges them. Again this appears to be amongst the youngest children, but as part of school wide monitoring, all leaders will be spending time talking to the children about their learning and how they

	feel about it.
I enjoy reading and sharing books	Mrs Machin, our English lead, has already implemented some new reading for pleasure initiatives this term. They include every child having the opportunity to take an additional reading for pleasure book home, our new book swap initiative, increased time within the classroom to read for pleasure, as well as the creation of an outdoor reading area. She is also going to be talking to the children about reading to explore what they do and don't like about it.
I think that children behave well in my school	We agree that some children found meeting school expectations challenging last academic year and that on our return in September this needed to be revisited. As a result, lots of work has already taken place to ensure all children are aware of expectations and how we expect them to meet them. We are really pleased to say that we have already seen a positive shift back towards the exemplary behaviour our school is proud to be known for but we are also going to work with the school council to review our behaviour policy to ensure it continues to be right for the children who attend our school.
