Construct and Create

Grades: 1st - 3rd OR 4th - 6th

Description: Get ready to unleash your inner inventor and artist in this exciting semester class where curiosity meets creativity, giving young learners the chance to dream, design, and build amazing projects. We'll explore everything from architecture, sculpture, and functional gadgets, using a hands-on approach with a wide variety of materials. Each week will challenge students to problem-solve, collaborate, and experiment as they create and foster both their technical skills and imagination in a fun, enriching environment.

Hooked on Drawing

Ages: 1st - 6th

Description: Do you love to doodle, sketch, or imagine cool pictures in your head? Hooked on Drawing is the perfect way to learn how to bring those ideas to life! You'll start with the basics—like lines, shapes, and shading—and then build up to exciting skills like texture, space, and perspective (that's how things look near or far). Instead of copying, you'll make creative choices, solve problems, and use your imagination to create drawings that are uniquely yours.

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Every activity is like a fun challenge where you get to experiment, explore, and show off your artistic voice.

The Idea Factory

Grades: 1st - 5th OR 1st - 6th

Description: Welcome to The Idea Factory, the art class where you choose! You get to pick the subject—whether it's a fantastic beast, a favorite food, or a wild abstract vision—and the media, allowing you to combine paint, clay, yarn, and markers to bring your ideas to life. In this class, you will master the elements of art (line, shape, form, texture, space, value, and color) which are the "secret ingredients" for creating amazing projects, learning how to use them to set a mood and define your work. Singing rounds and partner songs will help students develop listening and harmonic skills. Experience reading music is beneficial, but not required. Reading words is helpful, but also not required for enrolling in this class. Choir performs at the Open House held at the end of each semester.

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Keyboard Rocks!

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: This is a class for students interested in learning to play the keyboard, and is designed for beginners. Focus for the semester will be becoming familiar with the instrument, basic playing techniques, the musical alphabet and introduction to the musical staff. Because this class allows for more individualized instruction, the pace of learning will be set by each student and supported by Ms. Kate. Improvisation will be encouraged and facilitated in some way in each class. Students will have the opportunity to perform solos or duets at the end of the semester.

Ukulele 2

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: This is a fun and challenging class for students who have had at least one semester of Ukulele 1 at HSC, or who have some experience playing ukulele outside of HSC. We will go deeper into different rhythm/strumming patterns, learn several new chords, learn variations on the chords that we already know, and learn more complex songs. We will also have a songwriting component where students will compose songs individually and in groups! This class will have the exciting opportunity to perform in Open House at the end of the semester.

Dance Designers

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: Do you love to dance? Do you love being on stage? Do you love coming up with your own performances? If you answered yes to any of these questions, then Dance Designers might be the right class for you! In Dance Designers, students will learn some common dance moves in different styles before collaborating as a class to choreograph a number they will perform at Open House. We will use different acting and dance exercises to explore how we can translate the music and lyrics of a song into a captivating stage performance!

Improv

Grades: 1st - 5th

Description: Students will participate in various theatre games and improvisation exercises that will give them the skills to be more confident actors and individuals. Improv is all about creativity, confidence, and a willingness to take risks! This class will not perform at Open House because the focus is on skill-building, rather than becoming performance-ready.

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Musical Theatre

****this class is a continuation from the fall, no new students will be added as parts have already been assigned****

Grades: 1st - 8th

Fee: Tickets to attend the Musical will be available for purchase in the spring

Description: HSC's DRAMA and MUSIC departments are joining forces! We will combine talents by incorporating dancing, singing, and acting into one larger than life musical production.

Students will experience what a traditional rehearsal process is like in class before performing in a full production of the year's chosen musical at the end of the year. This class is 100% performance-focused and students should be prepared to rehearse each day they come to class. Good attendance for both semesters is mandatory, please advise teachers of upcoming (planned) absences. Students should be prepared to work on lines, lyrics, and choreography outside of class.

Requirements: This is a year-long class and will rely heavily on attendance. This class cannot be joined or transferred out of mid-year. Keep in mind that auditions are held the 3rd week of class, so it's best to decide on this class by the 1st week. Students will be expected to work on lines, songs, and choreography outside of class. This class is run more like a professional rehearsal process for a children's theatre and less like the other performance classes at HSC.

Page to Stage

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: In Page to Stage, students will explore the world of theatre with the help of children's stories, fairy tales, and poems throughout the semester! Throughout the semester we will read a story that will help guide and inspire various activities exploring acting, improvisation, mime, pantomime, and all the ways we can bring words on a page to life. This class will not perform at Open House and thus provides a low-pressure environment for anyone looking to dip their toes into the world of theatre. During the Spring 2026 semester we will be using the following stories: "Where the Wild Things Are" by Maurice Sendak, "Eraser" by Anna

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Kang, “Snowy Day” by Ezra Jack Keats, “The Smart Cookie” by Jory John, “The Monster Who Lost His Mean” by Tiffany Strelitz Haber, and Shel Silverstein poetry.

Technical Theatre

Ages: 4th - 6th

Description: Are you interested in theatre, but don't want to be onstage? Join other students to explore the following technical elements of theatre: Set design, Costume design, Light design, Sound design, Props design, Marketing, and House Management. Students will learn what each technical element is, why it is important, and spend some time exploring and creating their own designs for each area. Students will also help prepare and run various school wide events scheduled during each semester. The biggest focus in this class is working on various projects needed for the Spring Musical. There are high expectations in this class for good behavior and a sense of responsibility when helping run our school wide events. **Students may take this class one or both semesters, taking both semesters is highly recommended.**

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Each class brings a new case to crack — from puzzling powders to secret messages — using real scientific skills like observing, testing, and making smart guesses (aka hypotheses!). With fun experiments, teamwork challenges, and brain-boosting clues, students will dive into the scientific method while learning how to think like true science detectives. Get ready for a thrilling adventure full of discoveries, surprises, and science-powered problem-solving!

Wonderful Water

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: Get ready to dive into the science of H₂O! In Wonderful Water, students will explore the amazing properties of water through fun, hands-on experiments and engaging activities each week. From discovering how water moves and changes, to testing surface tension, density, and absorption, this class uses curiosity-driven learning to explore the wonders of water. We'll build mini rain clouds, make water walk, explore how objects float or sink, and even create capillary action experiments! Each activity encourages observation, prediction, critical thinking, and messy fun – all while helping kids build a strong foundation in scientific thinking. Come make a splash in science with us!



Bot Battles ***Students must take the HSC Tech Tour concurrently or last semester as a prerequisite to take this course.***

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: Welcome to the exhilarating world of Bot Battles! In this class, young engineers will unleash their creativity as they design and construct battle-ready structures using various materials. From boats to cars and beyond, students will power their creations with different robots and explore the dynamic capabilities of Spheros, Ozobots, Dash and Dot, and Indi bots. Teams will collaborate to complete challenges and face off in friendly competitions, testing their designs and strategies against classmates. Through hands-on building and problem-solving, participants will discover essential engineering principles, coding concepts, and teamwork skills.

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Get ready for an electrifying experience where imagination takes shape, and students turn their innovative designs into formidable contenders in the ultimate multi-bot showdown!

Card Cadets

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: Get ready to shuffle, deal, and play! In this upbeat class, students dive into the world of classic 52-card decks while creating a custom deck of their very own. Digital Art Lab II *****Students must take the HSC Tech Tour concurrently or last semester as a prerequisite to take this course.*****

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: Prepare to level up your creative game! This class dives into the most advanced and exciting concepts of digital art, design, and fabrication. You'll start by mastering the fundamentals of pixel art and vector graphics, and even learn to animate your creations! Then, you'll learn to use a heat press for sublimation printing, transforming your digital designs into real-world items you can take home! Next we will explore the world of digital photography and advanced photo editing techniques. By the end of this unit you will have created a professional photography portfolio showcasing your best work! Finally, we transition to the amazing world of 3D design. Using the user-friendly but powerful TinkerCAD software, you will develop serious 3D modeling skills and watch as your virtual creations are brought into the physical world using a 3D printer! From pixels to products, join us and become the ultimate digital artist and designer!

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HSC Tech Tour (Note - this class is a prerequisite for Bot Battles, Digital Art Lab II, Lego Robotics and Coding, Minecraft Mods, Newscast, Prime Robotics, Sitcom Shenanigans and Scratch Lab, unless otherwise approved by the teacher)

Grades: 1st - 6th

Teacher: Mr. Wolf nwolf@wwahomeschool.org

Description: In this class, students will have the opportunity to learn the basics of technology through fun, engaging lessons. Basic skills will include logging into a computer, using a mouse, finding letters on the keyboard, and much more. After students have become comfortable with these basic skills, they will then be introduced to a variety of technology applications such as Sublimation, 3D Designing, a few robots, and various differing software using the laptops and iPads. They will explore new interests on this exciting “tour” of technology! **This class is a great class for introductions to new technology students have never used before! It will also prepare our students for other HSC classes!**

Lego Robotics and Coding ***Students must take the HSC Tech Tour concurrently or last semester as a prerequisite to take this course.***

Grades: 1st - 4th

Description: In this class students will work on building a variety of fun robots using the Lego Spike Essential program, and then coding them to make them come to life! From vehicles such as a street sweeper and a racecar that starts and stops on its own using a color sensor, to miniature amusement park rides, to sports-based robots such as a “mini mini golf” robot and a hockey rink where students will face off against a robot opponent, students will have a blast expanding their knowledge of robotics as they improve their mechanical engineering and coding skills. Spike uses a block-based coding platform, which will be familiar to any students who have used Scratch or the other block-based coding programs we explore in Tech Tour. Various coding challenges will be provided to individual student groups, so each student will be challenged at an appropriate level.

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Minecraft Mods *Students must take the HSC Tech Tour concurrently or last semester as a prerequisite to take this course.*****

Grades: 1st - 6th

Description: In Minecraft Mods, students will take their love for the popular game Minecraft, and use it in a constructive manner! They will focus on their planning and design skills, mapping out large-scale structures and working as a team to accomplish the builds. Lesson topics include learning about redstone circuitry and machines, the use of command blocks to modify their world, and learning how to create their very own basic modifications to the dynamic Minecraft world. By the end of the semester, students will have worked together to create a thriving environment full of their ideas and builds!

This semester, students will work in teams to get their daily jobs completed and everyone will take a larger role in the editing process. For the upcoming semester, this class will only be offered to students in grades 4 -6.

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Prime Robotics ***Students must have taken Lego Robotics & Coding as a prerequisite to take this course.*** Students must take the HSC Tech Tour concurrently or last semester as a prerequisite to take this course.***

Grades: 5th - 8th

Description: Get ready to engineer the future! And dive into the electrifying world of robotics, where imagination meets real-world mechanics! Prime Robotics will elevate your engineering & coding skills through a fun & challenging robotics class. We will begin by exploring the capabilities of the awesome Spike Prime program, by building & coding a variety of exciting robots - including a frog-style hopper creature, a trash grabber, a breakdancing robot, and a motorcycle robot! As the semester goes you'll go from engineer and coder to inventor, using everything you've learned to design, build, and program robots of your own creation! Every lesson explores cool scientific concepts, and coding challenges will keep every student group challenged and engaged, no matter your experience level. What will you invent?

Sitcom Shenanigans ***Students must take the HSC Tech Tour concurrently or last semester as a prerequisite to take this course.***

Grades: 4th - 8th

Shows will be recorded and edited on an iPad using both iMovies and Canva. It's a wonderful blend of creativity, tech skills and humor!
