## Portsmouth founding Bill

The importance of our naval forces can't be understated. This bill is intended to give the Ministry guidance for the establishment of a new city.

- 1. The Ministry and Governor of London are to foster the creation of another city on the coast.
  - a. The City so founded shall forever bear the name *Portsmouth*.
  - b. The city must have a tile suitable for a Republican Dockyard.
  - c. If feasible, an environment with high production bonuses shall be chosen.
  - d. The requirements of this paragraph shall not be construed to require the founding of Portsmouth in a location deemed indefensible or unsuitable for any city, in the opinion of the Ministry or the founding Governor.
  - e. The requirements of this paragraph shall not be construed to prevent the founding of other cities deemed necessary to England's growth, while a suitable location for Portsmouth is yet to be identified.
- 2. The Governor overseeing Portsmouth is guided, but not required, to develop the city as the center of English naval production through the following actions:
  - a. Construction of a Republican Dockyard
  - b. improvement of production resources
  - c. Production of the most advanced naval units available.
- 3. The Governor overseeing Portsmouth is further guided, but not required, to construct a Lighthouse for military signaling purposes.
