

Every ninja has its strengths and weaknesses. Some are stronger than others, some are faster, some take better hits, etc etc etc. This is where the ninja stat system comes in. If you were here before the reboot the system is the same with a few minor touch ups. Literally. Like you could copy and paste stats and be okay. I did it with Choziin cause lazy.

To anyone new we use a loose “comparison” system. It is by no means meant to be adhered to as the answer to who wins what fight. it should not deter you from fighting someone unless you’re like a genin walking up to a jonin asking for a fight to the death. Then maybe you should reconsider.

They system will work of the power ranks and/or an accompanying words. please put words on your stat areas.

- No skill (this is not a rank and just up to the RPer. You cannot "buff" no skill stats.)
- Poor = academy or E rank
- Below average = D
- Average = C
- Above average = B
- Skilled = A
- Talented = S

Gifted: Gifted will be a special option that will be limited in numbers, can only be given by majority mod vote, and are tied to something that is canonical. Prime example is being a jinchuriki. If you are one then you will, or well, can take gifted amounts of chakra. Another example is someone who takes FTG. You can have gifted amounts of speed.

Gifted stats are not negotiable. You cannot make a reason to have a gifted stat. so no “I made my own bijuu” or clan and have uber amounts of chakra. you can have a talented amount of chakra, but thats it. (and for the record ranks dont stack. so if you play an uzumaki and we give you the kyuubi you dont get both huge amounts of chakra to make a super huge amount of chakra. just the bijuu amount)

As explained in other doc, being one level above or below another ninja does not make a one sided fight.

If ninja X had C rank taijutsu and ninja Y has B rank taijutsu the stats are the virtually equal and there is no real, viable advantage, unless one ninja uses fire and the other uses water.

If ninja X with c rank ninjutsu fights ninja Z with a rank taijutsu and they both use then there is a noticeable advantage but it is not a one sided fight.

If ninja X with C rank strength punches fists with Ninja Q with s rank strength then there is a one sided lose and ninja C will be showing some form of serious damage. But then ninja X shouldnt be fighting ninja Q alone anyways

Bufs

Bufs work in two ways, aesthetic and ranks.

A rank buff is done by a ninja to increase a stat. example is an Akimichi expansion. There will be an obvious buff in strength when you're the size of the Gedo statue. This is also the kind of buff you would receive from the 8 gates.

An aesthetic buff is a form of false or limited buff. example is if you combine fire and wind or lightning and water. Or if one jutsu overcomes and swallows another of the same chakra nature. Any of these are not permanent buffs to your ninjutsu stat but result in a "buffed" attack. Aesthetic buffs come in other forms as well but a simple way to think of it is as one that takes immediate affect and does not raise a stat but the power of an attack or defense itself.
