National Security & Defense Policy

The Adorian New Democrats believe that a secure and sovereign Adoria is the foundation upon which prosperity, unity, and freedom are built. National security is not merely about military strength; it is about protecting the nation's people, institutions, economy, and territory from all threats—foreign and domestic—while upholding the democratic values and rule of law that define our republic. Our approach to security and defense is pragmatic, proactive, and focused on ensuring that Adoria can defend itself independently, cooperate with trusted allies, and respond to the complex challenges of the modern world.

Sovereignty and Self-Defense

The sovereignty of Adoria is non-negotiable. In light of recent foreign military activities within our borders, we will take decisive steps to assert our rights over our territory, airspace, and waters. We will continue to demand the full withdrawal of any foreign troops or equipment stationed in Adoria without the express consent of our government. Our Armed Forces will be given the necessary resources and legal authority to monitor, secure, and, if required, restrict access to any base, port, or airfield currently under foreign control without Adorian consent.

We will also review all existing military agreements to ensure they are transparent, mutually beneficial, and subject to parliamentary oversight. Any future security partnerships must respect our independence, our laws, and our democratic institutions.

Military Readiness and Modernisation

Our Armed Forces must be prepared to respond to threats quickly, decisively, and effectively. We will undertake a complete modernization program for the Army, Navy, and Air Force, focusing on:

- Updating equipment and technology to meet modern combat, surveillance, and cyber-defense requirements.
- Expanding domestic defense manufacturing to reduce reliance on foreign suppliers. Improving training and readiness through joint exercises with trusted regional partners and NATO members where cooperation aligns with our national interest.
- Restructuring force deployment so that units are positioned to respond rapidly to emergencies both at home and abroad.

We will ensure that our military is properly funded and that defense spending is efficient, transparent, and directed toward capabilities that directly strengthen our national defense rather than serve foreign policy objectives of other nations.

Cybersecurity and Intelligence

Modern threats are not limited to conventional warfare. Cyberattacks, disinformation campaigns, and foreign espionage pose serious risks to Adoria's economy, democracy, and way of life. The Adorian New Democrats will:

- Establish a National Cyber Defense Command tasked with preventing, detecting, and responding to cyber threats against government institutions, critical infrastructure, and private industry.
- Increase investment in cybersecurity education and recruitment to ensure we have a skilled workforce defending our digital frontiers.
- Strengthen cooperation between intelligence services, law enforcement, and the private sector to counter online extremism, hostile state actors, and criminal networks.

Border Security and Migration

Strong borders are essential to maintaining both security and public trust. While Adoria will remain a welcoming nation for genuine refugees, skilled workers, and legal migrants, we will take a measured and fair approach to migration in line with our capacity to integrate newcomers into society without straining our welfare system.

We will:

- Implement a new migration model, ensuring all immigration policies are sustainable and in the national interest.
- Improve border surveillance and control through modern technology, additional staffing, and streamlined cooperation between border agencies.

- Crack down on human trafficking and cross-border organized crime.

Civil Defense and Disaster Preparedness

National security is not only about military threats—it also means protecting our people from natural disasters, pandemics, industrial accidents, and other emergencies. Adoria’s current disaster readiness is poor, and the New Democrats will fix this. We will:

- Create a National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) to coordinate disaster planning, response, and recovery across all levels of government.
- Invest in infrastructure resilience, including flood defenses, earthquake preparedness, and fire prevention measures.
- Conduct regular national emergency drills to ensure citizens know how to respond in crises.
- Stockpile essential supplies and maintain rapid deployment teams for humanitarian and civil protection missions.

Counter-Terrorism and Internal Security

We face evolving threats from extremist groups, organized crime, and radicalized individuals. The Adorian New Democrats will:

- Strengthen counter-terrorism laws to give security agencies the tools they need while safeguarding civil liberties.
- Improve intelligence-sharing between agencies to detect and disrupt plots before they can be carried out.
- Expand community policing and counter-radicalization programs to address the root causes of extremism.

Veterans and Military Families

Those who serve our country deserve the highest level of respect, care, and support. We will:

- Guarantee comprehensive healthcare, mental health services, and rehabilitation programs for veterans.
- Ensure fair pensions and career transition programs to help veterans re-enter the civilian workforce.
- Provide strong support systems for military families, including housing, childcare, and educational assistance.

Strategic Alliances and International Engagement

While Adoria is no longer a NATO member, we remain committed to building strong, mutually respectful partnerships around the world. Our foreign policy will be guided by the principles of non-interference, mutual benefit, and national sovereignty.

We will:

- Strengthen bilateral security agreements with nations that respect our independence.
- Participate in joint peacekeeping, humanitarian, and anti-piracy missions where they align with our values and national interest.
- Engage in regional security dialogues to prevent conflicts and promote stability.

Economics Policy

Introduction

The Adorian New Democrats believe that a strong economy is the foundation for a prosperous, fair, and stable nation. In an era where Adoria faces significant economic headwinds, negative GDP growth, high inflation, and a troubling poverty rate. We are committed to implementing pragmatic and sustainable reforms that encourage innovation, create good jobs, and protect the most vulnerable.

Our economic vision is rooted in the principles of **pragmatism, stability, and shared prosperity**. We reject ideological extremes that either abandon public responsibility or suffocate private enterprise. We will adopt a balanced approach—retaining public control over strategic sectors while introducing targeted privatisation in non-strategic areas to boost competition, improve efficiency, and expand opportunities for private investment.

Our policies will be designed to work within Adoria's current monetary reality—our use of the euro—and will focus on economic reforms that leverage our national strengths, reduce vulnerability to global shocks, and ensure fair distribution of wealth.

Macroeconomic Stability

Adoria's most recently updated economic indicators paint a challenging picture:

- GDP Growth: **-4.3%**
- Inflation: **7.8%**
- Poverty Rate: **12%+**

We will tackle these challenges head-on with a **four-pillar stability plan**:

1. **Stimulate Sustainable Growth** – Introduce an emergency public works programme focused on infrastructure renewal, housing development, and environmental protection projects. This will directly inject funds into the economy, create jobs, and increase demand for domestic materials and services.
2. **Control Inflation** – Work closely with the European Central Bank (ECB) to ensure interest rate policy is calibrated to Adoria’s needs while using targeted fiscal measures, such as subsidising essential goods and services during periods of price instability, to protect households.
3. **Poverty Reduction** – Introduce a “Pathway to Prosperity” programme that combines direct financial support for low-income families with skills training, small business grants, and local employment guarantees in public and private projects.
4. **Fiscal Responsibility** – Commit to balanced budgets over the medium term by improving tax collection efficiency, closing loopholes, and prioritising investments that produce measurable returns for the economy.

Taxation Reform

Our tax system must be fair, efficient, and growth-friendly. The Adorian New Democrats will:

- Introduce a Modernised Tax Code – Simplify the tax code, reduce compliance costs for individuals and businesses, and make tax obligations clearer and more predictable.
- Progressive Personal Income Tax – Protect low- and middle-income earners by adjusting tax brackets to inflation and increasing the tax-free allowance, while asking the wealthiest to contribute a fairer share.
- Corporate Tax Reform – Reduce the headline corporate tax rate for small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) to encourage entrepreneurship and job creation, while ensuring multinational corporations pay their fair share through anti-avoidance measures.
- Green Incentives Without Carbon Tax – While we oppose a carbon tax, we will offer tax credits for investments in renewable energy, energy efficiency, and sustainable transport.
- Combat Tax Evasion – Strengthen enforcement capacity and introduce digital tools for tax monitoring and fraud detection.

Strategic Public Ownership & Targeted Privatisation

We believe that public ownership has a vital role in safeguarding strategic industries and ensuring equitable access to essential services. However, where the public sector is managing non-strategic industries that could be more efficient in private hands, we will carefully introduce privatisation.

We will retain 100% public control of:

- Healthcare & Pharmaceuticals
- Education (all levels)
- Parks & Recreation
Childcare
- Construction (strategic housing and infrastructure projects)

- Core Defence Manufacturing & Supply Chains

We will consider partial or full privatisation in:

- Processed Food & Drinks
- Adhesives & Abrasives
- Batteries
- Steel & Aluminium
- Non-strategic agricultural, forestry, and fisheries operations

Privatisation will be implemented gradually, with strong regulatory oversight to prevent monopolies, protect workers, and ensure continued service availability.

Job Creation & Employment Policy

To combat unemployment and underemployment, we will:

1. Launch the National Works Programme – Hire workers for public infrastructure, environmental restoration, and maintenance projects.
2. Encourage Private Investment in Job-Rich Sectors – Offer incentives for manufacturing, tourism, green technology, and digital industries.
3. Vocational Training & Retraining – Expand trade schools, apprenticeships, and adult learning programmes to fill skills gaps in construction, healthcare, and emerging industries.
4. Local Employment Guarantees – Ensure that major government-funded projects source at least 50% of labour locally.

Support for Small Business & Innovation

Small and medium enterprises are the backbone of our economy. We will:

- Provide low-interest startup loans for entrepreneurs in underserved communities.
- Establish innovation hubs in major cities and regional centres to support tech startups, creative industries, and advanced manufacturing.
- Simplify business registration and licensing to encourage formalisation of the informal economy.

Trade & Industry Development

Adoria's economic prosperity depends on competitive industries and robust trade relationships. We will:

- Diversify export markets to reduce reliance on a few trading partners.
- Negotiate fair trade agreements that protect Adorian jobs and environmental standards.

- Promote domestic manufacturing in high-value sectors such as pharmaceuticals, precision engineering, and renewable energy.

Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries

Agriculture remains a critical sector, both for food security and rural employment. We will:

- Retain public control over strategic agricultural resources.
- Allow private ownership and operation in non-strategic crop and fisheries markets to increase efficiency and innovation.
- Provide targeted subsidies for sustainable farming, soil health improvement, and climate-resilient practices.

Housing & Urban Development

Housing affordability and urban renewal will be central to our economic plan:

- Expand public housing projects to reduce waiting lists.
- Offer incentives for private developers to build affordable housing in urban and regional areas.
- Prioritise urban planning that reduces traffic congestion and improves access to public transport.

Infrastructure & Transport Investment

Modern infrastructure is key to productivity:

- Upgrade road, rail, and port infrastructure to improve connectivity for businesses and commuters.
- Invest in renewable energy grids, water management systems, and digital infrastructure.
- Use public-private partnerships (PPPs) where appropriate, ensuring strong public oversight.

Regional Development

Balanced growth means no community is left behind:

- Establish regional economic development funds to invest in industries suited to each area's strengths.
- Improve access to healthcare, education, and digital services in rural areas.
- Support tourism in underdeveloped regions through targeted marketing and infrastructure upgrades.

Financial Sector Reform

We will strengthen the financial system to support the real economy:

- Encourage ethical banking practices and transparency.
- Regulate to prevent predatory lending and protect consumers.
- Support the development of credit unions and cooperative banking in rural areas.

Measuring Success

The Adorian New Democrats will evaluate economic policy by tracking:

- Annual GDP growth rate (target: 2–3% sustained growth)
- Inflation rate (target: 2–3% stability)
- Poverty rate reduction (goal: under 8% within 5 years)
- Unemployment rate (goal: under 5% within 5 years)

We will provide annual public reports to ensure transparency and accountability.

Justice & Police Policy

The Adorian New Democrats are committed to building a justice system that is fair, transparent, and trusted by the public. We believe in the rule of law, equal treatment for all citizens, and the protection of rights and freedoms without prejudice or political influence. At the same time, we recognise the urgent need to address high crime rates, improve public safety, and ensure that our law enforcement agencies have the resources, training, and accountability necessary to perform their duties effectively.

Criminal Justice Reform

Our party will prioritise a justice system that focuses on rehabilitation where possible, while ensuring that serious and violent crimes face swift and decisive consequences. We will review sentencing guidelines to ensure they are proportionate and fair, while eliminating unnecessary delays in court proceedings. Special attention will be given to tackling corruption, organised crime, and white-collar offences, which undermine both public trust and economic stability.

We will expand access to legal aid, ensuring that every Adorian has the right to adequate representation regardless of their financial means. This will be supported by a modernised court infrastructure, digital case management systems, and better coordination between law enforcement and judicial bodies to reduce case backlogs.

Policing and Public Safety

Our police forces are the first line of defence against crime and disorder. We will ensure they are well-funded, well-trained, and equipped to handle modern challenges, from cybercrime to gang

violence. Officers will receive enhanced training in de-escalation techniques, community engagement, and cultural awareness to build stronger relationships with the communities they serve.

We will implement a “Community Policing Initiative” across urban and rural areas, placing officers directly in neighbourhoods to work alongside residents in preventing crime before it occurs. This will also involve expanding the use of crime prevention programs in schools and public spaces.

Tackling High Crime Rates

Given Adoria’s current high crime levels, the Adorian New Democrats will take a multi-faceted approach:

- Targeting repeat offenders with strict monitoring and rehabilitation programs.
- Breaking the cycle of youth crime through early intervention, vocational training, and mentoring.
- Disrupting organised crime networks through better intelligence sharing between agencies and increased international cooperation.
- Combating drug trafficking with stronger border controls, modern scanning technology at ports, and specialised anti-drug units.

Road Safety and Traffic Law Enforcement

The high rate of traffic accidents in Adoria demands urgent attention. We will strengthen traffic law enforcement, implement automated speed and red-light cameras in high-risk zones, and require advanced road safety training for commercial drivers. Road infrastructure will be reviewed to identify dangerous intersections and poorly designed highways, with priority given to upgrades in accident-prone areas. Public awareness campaigns will target drunk driving, distracted driving, and reckless behaviour on the roads.

Anti-Corruption and Accountability

Public trust in law enforcement and the justice system cannot exist without strong mechanisms for accountability. We will establish an **Independent Police and Justice Oversight Commission** to investigate allegations of misconduct by police officers, judges, and prosecutors. Transparency will be reinforced by publishing annual reports on the state of justice, crime statistics, and the outcomes of corruption investigations.

Prison System Reform

While punishment is necessary for serious crimes, the prison system should also aim to reduce reoffending. The Adorian New Democrats will modernise correctional facilities, increase access to education and job training for inmates, and provide post-release support to help former offenders reintegrate into society. For non-violent offenders, we will expand the use of community service,

electronic monitoring, and restorative justice programs to reduce prison overcrowding and focus resources on high-risk individuals.

Disaster & Emergency Law Enforcement Support

In light of Adoria's poor disaster readiness, our law enforcement agencies will play an expanded role in national emergency response. Police will be trained in disaster relief operations, evacuation procedures, and coordination with civil defence units to ensure rapid response in times of crisis.

Technology & Modernisation

To stay ahead of emerging threats, we will invest in advanced forensic labs, cybercrime units, and modern investigative tools. The use of body-worn cameras will be expanded to promote accountability, protect officers, and build community trust. Data analysis systems will help predict crime trends and allocate police resources more effectively.

By implementing these policies, the Adorian New Democrats will create a justice and law enforcement system that keeps Adoria safe, upholds democratic values, and earns the confidence of the people it serves.

Foreign Policy

The Adorian New Democrats believe that Adoria's prosperity, security, and global influence depend on a foreign policy rooted in diplomacy, mutual respect, and international cooperation. We will pursue a principled yet pragmatic approach to global engagement, ensuring that Adoria's voice is heard on the world stage while protecting our national interests.

Diplomatic Principles

Our foreign policy will be guided by three core principles:

1. **Sovereignty and Self-Determination** – Adoria will respect the sovereignty of all nations and oppose interference in the internal affairs of others, while defending our own independence and right to self-governance.
2. **Mutual Benefit and Partnership** – We will prioritise trade, security, and cultural agreements that deliver tangible benefits to the Adorian people.
3. **Global Responsibility** – As a responsible member of the international community, Adoria will contribute to peacekeeping, humanitarian aid, and the fight against global challenges such as climate change, pandemics, and organised crime.

Bilateral and Multilateral Relations

We will strengthen relations with our neighbours, building a stable regional environment through dialogue, cross-border infrastructure projects, and shared security initiatives. Adoria will maintain active participation in multilateral organisations, using these platforms to promote fair trade rules, human rights, and conflict resolution.
