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Healthcare Careers

Medical Laboratory Scientist / Technologist: Performs lab tests across disciplines (microbiology, genetics, toxicology); salaries vary by specialty

Dental Hygienists: Require an associate degree; median pay ~\$87.5K; projected job growth ~7%

Respiratory Therapists: Median pay ~\$62K–78K; growth ~13%

Rise of middle-skill technical roles: Jobs like sterile-processing techs, radiologic techs, and lab support offer solid pay (\$50K–70K/year) with short training pathways.

AtlantiCare Internships

Internships at AtlantiCare is a time-limited, paid and non-paid work placement that allows students or recent grads to gain practical experience in a real work environment. Typically offered during the academic year or summer and may be full- or part-time, remote or in person. The opportunities are clinical and non-clinical roles.

High School Hiring Blitz

Hiring blitz for graduating high school students is a fast-paced, large-scale recruiting event or campaign designed to quickly fill part-time or seasonal job openings. The blitzes are usually organized between AtlantiCare, school districts, or community organizations that focuses on connecting students with immediate job opportunities after high school in the Health Science space.

Key Features of the Hiring Blitz:

1. Fast-Paced Hiring:

- o Aim to conduct interviews, make decisions, and even offer jobs on the spot.
- o Often held over a single day or a short period.

2. Student-Focused:

- o Tailored for high school students who may have little to no work experience.
- o Jobs offered are typically part-time, flexible, or seasonal.

3. On-the-Spot Interviews:

- o Students may be interviewed and hired during the event.

4. Partnerships:

- o Collaboration with the local high schools to bring job opportunities directly to students.
- o Events are held in school gyms, cafeterias, or community centers.

5. Support Services:

- o Workshops on resume building, interview skills, or how to apply for work permits (if required).
- o Offer guidance on balancing school and work.
