4. **The same registration form to be used to paste the youtube links of the participant videos against the competitions mentioned in the registration form.**
5. **Last date of video/picture submission/upload is, 10th August 2024**
6. The school Coordinators are requested to mention correct spellings of the participating students.
7. Acknowledgement email for the registration will be sent on the registered email address mentioned in the registration form.
8. School coordinators are requested to go through the event wise '**Rules & Regulations**' and adhere to the same.
9. **1 child can participate in only 1 event.**
10. Participants should wear school ID-card during any the Video recording.
11. The School Uniform is a must for all the participants, **except wherever specific costumes are mentioned for the event.**
12. Top 2 winners will be announced for each event.
13. The decision about the winners of the events taken by the core committee will be binding and final.

Format	: On Campus (MIS)
Grade	: 5 & 6
Subject	: Art
Theme	: Zero Hunger
Event Brief	: POP ART
Medium	: Poster colour (or) Acrylic colours
No. of Rounds	: One
Individual Event / Group Event	: Individual Event
Maximum Participants	: Maximum 5 participants per school
Competition Duration	: 1 Hour

Rules & Regulations:

1. Participants have to draw the artwork and colour it using Poster colour (or) Acrylic colours (Using coloured papers is not allowed).
2. A black sketch pen/Marker is allowed for the outline.
3. All the material required for the competition is to be brought by the participants.
4. Size of the art paper - A4
5. Participants must complete their artwork within the given time limit.

2. Music Melodies

Name of the Event	: Music Melodies
Grade	: Grades 5-6 Group singing
Event Brief	: English Group singing.
No. of Rounds	: One
Theme	: Abode (Earth - a beautiful residence to live)
Maximum Participants	: One group with min 6 and max 10 participants per school.
Time Duration	: Maximum 4 minutes

Rules & Regulations:

1. The song selected should be relevant to the theme.
2. Songs should be appropriate to the theme and **participants can choose movie songs which are related to the theme and have good lyrics and meaning. Decency in choosing songs/lyrics is highly expected. (Objectionable lyrics in the songs will lead to disqualification.)**
3. Participants can use karaoke for the performance.
4. In case the participants want to perform on live music, **only participants have to play the instruments. (No teacher is allowed.)**
5. Participants can use any musical instrument of their choice.
6. Only english songs are allowed.
7. Must shoot their video in one shot without any cuts, editing or adding special effects in the video are strictly prohibited. And doing this will lead to automatic disqualification.
8. Participants should upload the recorded video to youtube and share the link of the same in the registration form.

3. Dancing Stars

Name of the Event	: Dancing Stars
Grade	: Grades 5-6 Group dance
No. of Rounds	: One
Theme	: International Folk Dances
Maximum Participants	: One group with min 5 and max 15 participants per school.
Event Brief	: Group dance competition where participants have to perform any International Folk dance style.
Topic	: International Folk Dances

Rules & Regulations:

1. One Group from each school can take part in the competition.
2. The duration of the dance is 4 minutes max.
3. Can use one or more songs/medley to perform within the given duration.
4. Children Need to use a Property in their dance which is Mandatory..**Any material used for the competition to be strictly eco friendly. Thermocol usage is strictly not allowed..**
5. Songs should be appropriate to the theme and **participants can choose movie songs which are related to the theme and have good lyrics and meaning. Decency in choosing songs/lyrics is highly expected. (Objectionable lyrics in the songs will lead to disqualification.)**
6. Students need to submit their video performing dance on the theme mentioned above.
7. Must Maintain Decorum in choosing the songs with appropriate lyrics, Costumes & Dance moves.
8. Must shoot their video in one shot without any cuts, editing or adding special effects in the video are strictly prohibited.
9. Must ensure that music is properly audible in the video.
10. Must not exceed the time limit as it leads to disqualification.
11. Must upload the video on Youtube and add the link of the same in the registration form at the time of registration.

Name of the Event	: GREEN TECH ENERGY
Format	: Online video submission
Grade	: 5 and 6
Subject	: Science
Theme	: Go green, breathe clean
Event Brief	: Working Model using renewable energy resources. Participating teams will showcase their scientific knowledge and skills with their innovative ideas which can be implemented for the benefit of mankind.
No. of Rounds	: One
Individual Event / Group Event	: Group Event
Maximum Participants	: 4 teams (2 Participants in a team) per school

Rules & Regulations:

1. Must wear a school uniform with an ID card. Participants need to submit their video on the theme mentioned above.
2. Ideas must be depicted through a working model along with a presentation.
3. Eco friendly materials to be used. **Thermocol usage is strictly not allowed.**
4. Must upload the video on Youtube and add the link of the same in the registration form at the time of registration. The model needs to be presented in the video in detail.
5. Must shoot their video in one shot without any cuts, editing or adding special effects in the video are strictly prohibited.
6. Must not exceed the time limit as it leads to disqualification.
7. Late entries are not acceptable.

5. GEOMETRIC GENIE

Name of the Event	: Geometric Genie
Participating Grades	: 5 and 6
No of participants	: Max of 2 teams (each team with min 2 and max 4 participants) per school. Max 8 participants from each school
Number of Rounds	: one
Theme	: "Geometric Genie: Unleashing the Power of Shapes"
Presentation Time	: 5 minutes per team

Event brief:

In this competition, teams will tap into their geometric skills and creativity to construct fascinating structures using 3D shapes. The challenge aims to foster teamwork, problem-solving, and spatial reasoning as participants work collaboratively to bring their imaginative creations to life.

Structure Creation:

Teams will have to work collaboratively and design their structures using a variety of 3D shapes. During this time, teams will need to strategize, plan, and construct their structures using their knowledge of geometric concepts. Participants are responsible for acquiring their own resources for the structure construction. They are encouraged to use a combination of reusable resources and waste materials.

Participants should use environmentally friendly options such as cardboard, paper, fabric scraps, wood, or other biodegradable materials. This challenge promotes resourcefulness and sustainability.

Rules & Regulations:

1. Participants need to shoot their video in one shot without any cuts, editing or adding special effects in the video are strictly prohibited.
2. Each team will have 5 minutes to present their structure they created. During the presentation, teams should focus on various aspects of their structure, including the creative use of 3D shapes, the stability of the construction, and their understanding of geometric principles. Teams should effectively communicate their ideas, showcasing their collaborative efforts, and highlight the mathematical concepts incorporated into their structures.
3. Must upload the video on Youtube and add the link of the same in the registration form at the time of registration. The model needs to be presented in the video in detail.

Judgment Criteria (20 points)

1. **Creativity (5 points):** Evaluate the originality and innovation demonstrated in the design and concept of the structure.
2. **Complexity (5 points):** Assess the complexity and variety of 3D shapes used in the structure.
3. **Presentation and Explanation (5 points):** Evaluate the clarity and effectiveness of the team's presentation, including their ability to explain their structure and its geometric components.
4. **Time Management (5 points):** Evaluate the efficient use of time throughout the event, including the construction and presentation phases

Name of the Event	: Pops of Pixels (Photography)
Format	: Online photo submission
Grade	: 5 - 6
No. of Rounds	: One
Individual Event / Group Event	: Individual Event
Maximum Participants	: Maximum 2 participants per school

Rules & Regulations:

1. The contests are open for online submissions only.
2. Submissions will not be accepted once the deadline lapses.
3. Photos submitted must be at least 640 pixels on the shorter side, and no more than 2000 pixels on the longer side. Images should be no larger than 2MB.
4. Photos must be in JPEG format.

5. All submitted photos must contain the original EXIF metadata information. However, there must be no border(s), logo(s), copyright marks, identifying marks, or any other visible references and/or marks on the image.
6. Basic editing, including colour enhancement, the use of filters, and cropping of the photo is acceptable, provided any such editing does not affect the authenticity and/or genuineness of the photo
7. Advanced editing used to create illusions, deceptions and/or manipulations, and the adding and removing of significant elements within the frame is prohibited.
8. Photos that portray or otherwise include inappropriate and/or offensive content, including provocative nudity, violence, human rights and/or environmental violation, and/or any other contents deemed to be contrary to the law, religious, cultural & moral traditions and practices around the world, are strictly prohibited and will be immediately discarded.
9. Submitted photos must be original, created and/or taken by the contestant. It must not contain any materials owned or controlled by a third party for which you have not obtained a license, must not infringe the copyright, trademark, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity.
10. Entries will not be accepted unless submitted via the official contest channel.
11. Entries will be judged by the school judging committee. All decisions are final. We reserve the right to disqualify any entry that is deemed inappropriate or does not conform to stated contest rules.
