A RESOLUTION TO IMPROVE TRAFFIC AND SAFETY TECHNOLOGY IN WALTHAM

WHEREAS, municipalities across the country continue to grapple with traffic congestion and safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, the City of Waltham is experiencing similar challenges; and

WHEREAS, these issues are exacerbated by increased traffic volume and violations; and

WHEREAS, frequent “quick stops” contribute to congestion and create safety hazards for pedestrians, cyclists, and other motorists; and

WHEREAS, Waltham has not yet implemented technological advancements to effectively address illegal parking, bike safety, and pedestrian protections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Waltham City Council hereby urges the Mayor to arrange for the City of Waltham to adopt a traffic technology system to address illegal parking behavior, bike, and pedestrian safety.
