What is Transitional Kindergarten?

It is designed to build a solid foundation for success in school for "young" five year olds.

The TK program is offered on a first-come first-served basis and has limited space and availability.

Is your child eligible to enroll?

If your child turns 5 by September 1st of 2026 then, "YES," your child is eligible for Transitional Kindergarten. Please refer to our TK Board Policy 6170.1 Please review the chart and graphic below!

How to enroll your child in TK:

- 1) Enrollment will begin February 20, 2025 for the 2025-2026 school year. You can enroll through the BHUSD's <u>NEW STUDENT ONLINE REGISTRATION PORTAL</u>
- 2) Be sure to follow the enrollment instructions, gather all the required and applicable documents, attach them to your online pre-enrollment application,

or email them to enrollment@bhusd.org Subject Line: Last/First/Grade/School Site or drop them off in the RED MAILBOX located outside our main building 624 N Rexford Drive, Beverly Hills CA 90210 (residency verification documents, health examination by private physician, dental form, required immunization records, additional registration forms).

TK Questions and Answers:

What is the difference between Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten? The Transitional Kindergarten classroom will provide developmentally appropriate thematic-based curriculum. The curriculum is a hybrid between the California Preschool Learning Foundations and the California Common Core Standards for Kindergarten. Students in the TK program will be provided a program that will bridge their early childhood experiences to those of the public school system.

Are students in TK also subject to kindergarten immunization requirements?

Yes. They are required to have documentation of immunizations or a valid medical exemption prior to admission to TK.

- Polio (OPV or IPV): 4 doses (3 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)
- Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis: 5 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT (4 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR or MMR-V): 2 doses (both given on or after 1st birthday)
- Hepatitis B (Hep B or HBV): 3 doses
- Varicella (Chickenpox, VAR, MMR-V, or VZV): 2 doses
