



Oscar and Junerose Beale Memorial Scholarship

Oscar was a 1942 graduate of Jefferson High School and attended the University of Missouri where he received his diesel engineering training. Oscar was employed in the diesel engine field all of his life and retired in 1986 from Stanadyne Corp. of Hartford, CT.

Oscar proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy from 1942 until 1946 during WWII. He served on the U.S.S. Monrovia his entire tour of duty, servicing the ship's engine. He was in nine major invasions, one in Sicily and the other eight in the South Pacific.
