FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Who is eligible for a scholarship?

A. Scholarships are awarded to graduates of FHS.

Q. How are the Awards made?

A. Students complete an application.

The Scholarship Committee who

manages the Awards and the Renewals.

Q. What is the Fredericktown High School Alumni Association Scholarship Fund?

A. The Scholarship Fund is a Permanent Endowment Fund, established for the purpose of guaranteeing scholarships for graduates of FHS. Only the growth on the principal will be used for awarding scholarships; therefore, it is a "gift that keeps on giving".

Q. How are Gifts recognized?

A. All Gifts help change lives and are appreciated. Every gift is acknowledged with a thank you note and tax receipt. Also, all gifts made during the year are listed in the Alumni Banquet Program as follows:

<\$100 – Freddie \$100> - Century \$250> - Silver \$500> - Gold

\$1,000> - Platinum

In addition, "Founder" gifts cumulating to \$1,000 or greater are permanently listed in the Alumni Banquet Program as follows:

\$1.000>: Founder

\$2,500>: Silver Founder \$5,000>: Gold Founder \$10,000>: Platinum Founder

Q. Are there "naming" opportunities for scholarships?

A. Yes, donors making gifts cumulating to \$10,000 or greater have the opportunity to "Name" a scholarship. Contact any member of the Fundraising Committee for details.
