- **Self-Release:**

- If you would like your student to walk home after their enrichment, please complete this [form](#). We cannot have ECE walk home alone but KG-5th graders are eligible.

- Late pickups are not allowed. We **HIGHLY** recommend that families are outside the designated pickup door 5 mins prior to the class ending. Any late pickup after 10 mins after class ending will result in a \$50 late fee charge that is due on MSB prior to the start of the next class. If it is not paid on time then your student will not be able to attend. After 3 late pickups, your student will be disenrolled without refund.

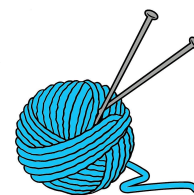
