AFTER SELECTION PROCESS:

An email will go out within two hours after the tryout with either

1) a welcome letter to join the team or **2)** a next step email.

If you do not receive any email, please check your **SPAM, and if you still have not received anything please email support@jrreign.com*

- All communication will be done electronically and privately, nothing will be posted at the rink. Our coaches and staff however will be available in person to discuss at the rink or to book a time to chat with them on the phone or zoom.
- Players will be receiving offer letters at all different times throughout the tryout process. If you have not received a welcome letter yet and a friend of yours has, it does not mean that your child has not made the team. We need to send out the agreements one by one for the whole club so please be patient and reach out to support@jrreign.com if you have specific questions or concerns about your child.

Signing Process:

You will receive a welcome letter and Player Agreement that will need to be completed within a specific time frame to confirm your spot on the team.

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1. Letter of Intent "LOI". On completion of the LOI which includes entering your

players league code and signing the player agreement, the parent has reserved the player's spot on the team and has committed to the team for the season.

2. Player Agreement Information and Season Plans. The player agreement includes club dues and may include player assessment fees, such as tournaments, and related expenses for the season. The club does its absolute best to lay out the plan for the season so that you have a good grasp on all potential fees and events. Please read your season plan for further explanation of what is and is not included in your player agreement.

3. Team Uniforms information and fitting days will be sent out after tryouts.
