Weekend Camping

Label all equipment

On Person

- Class A Shirt
- Hat
- Pocket Knife (must have totin chip)
- Hiking Boots
- Medicine (If Applicable) In 1 Gallon Ziploc Bag, original containers, with Index Card Instructions for Dosage – give to Medicine Man

Backpack

- Clothes
 - Class B Shirt or Hoodie
 - Appropriate clothes for the season
 - Extra shoes (in camp, crocs)
 - Extra socks
- Shelter/Sleeping
 - Sleeping Bag
 - Ground cloth
 - Tent
- 1 or 2 Nalgene water bottles with water
- Biodegradable Toilet paper or wipes
- Headlamp (check batteries)
- BSA Scout handbook
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Rain Gear
- Compass
- Mess Kit
- Utensils
- Sunscreen (non-aerosol)
- Bug repellent (non-aerosol)
- 25' paracord
- Toiletries
- 2 large garbage bags

Optional

- Camp chair
- Cards (uno, playing, ect..)
- Camera
- Sleeping Pad
- Hammock
- Sunglasses
- towel
