I kept watching along, and he went into a little bit of geopolitics, nothing too bad, some anthropology, honestly a bit of an undercover subject but it could've been a little less iffy, a fair amount of "hey the world isn't doing too good", which is understandable until it slowly and slowly devolved into massive hour long dense anti leftist screeds with a let's be honest left-coded voice yelling about the annihilation of western civilisation juxtaposed with pics of pride parades. And even that was not enough as it soon devolved into constant doom preaching about an imminent civil war in the US, a massive economic crash, even more rants against 'the marxists controlling the world' and finally, proclaiming the existence of a spirit world and a messianic message.

So that's a basic overview of my relationship with Rudyard Lynch, more publicly known as Whatifalthis.

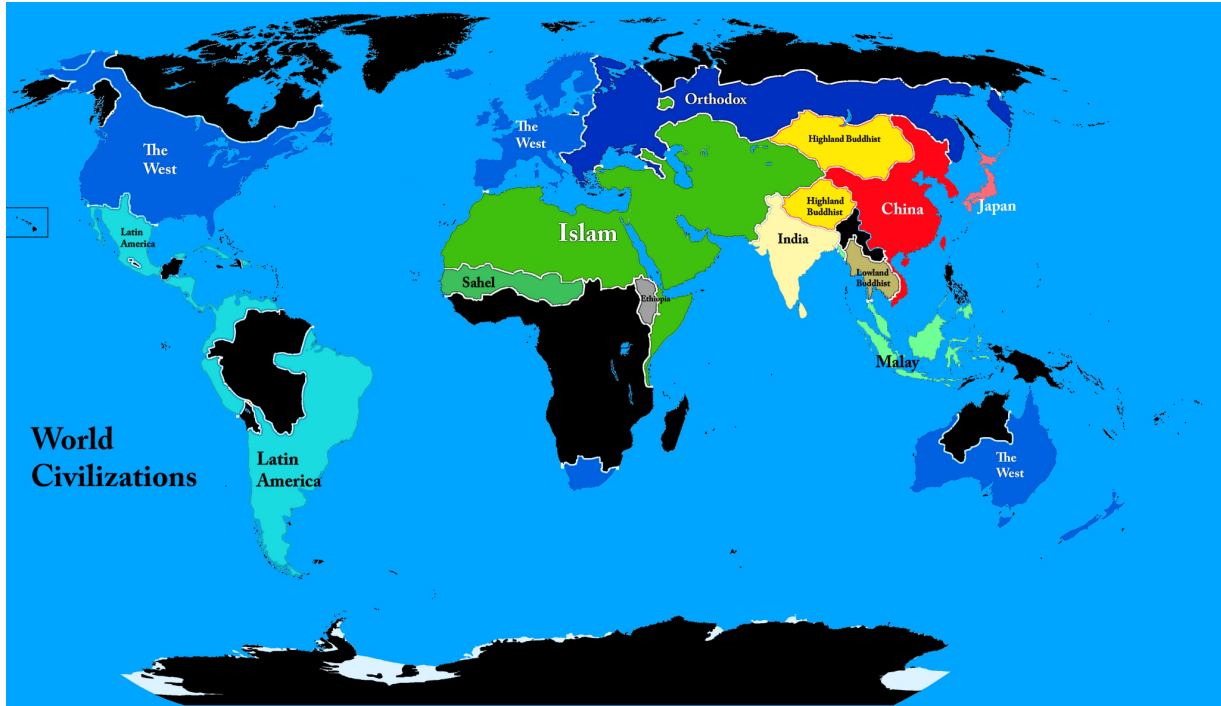
As a person who makes alternate history maps, it's pretty disturbing seeing someone who I practically considered my favorite youtuber devolve into a shrieking mess talking about how Odin visited him to tell him to make a list of all the women he masturbated to (he later mentioned that every single woman on the goon list was white).

Which is why I'm writing this completely unstructured rant and made that crazy post that probably led you to this. I will make many grammar mistakes and maybe one or three hundred logical errors. Here's a couple things that I found iffy about him.

The Historiography

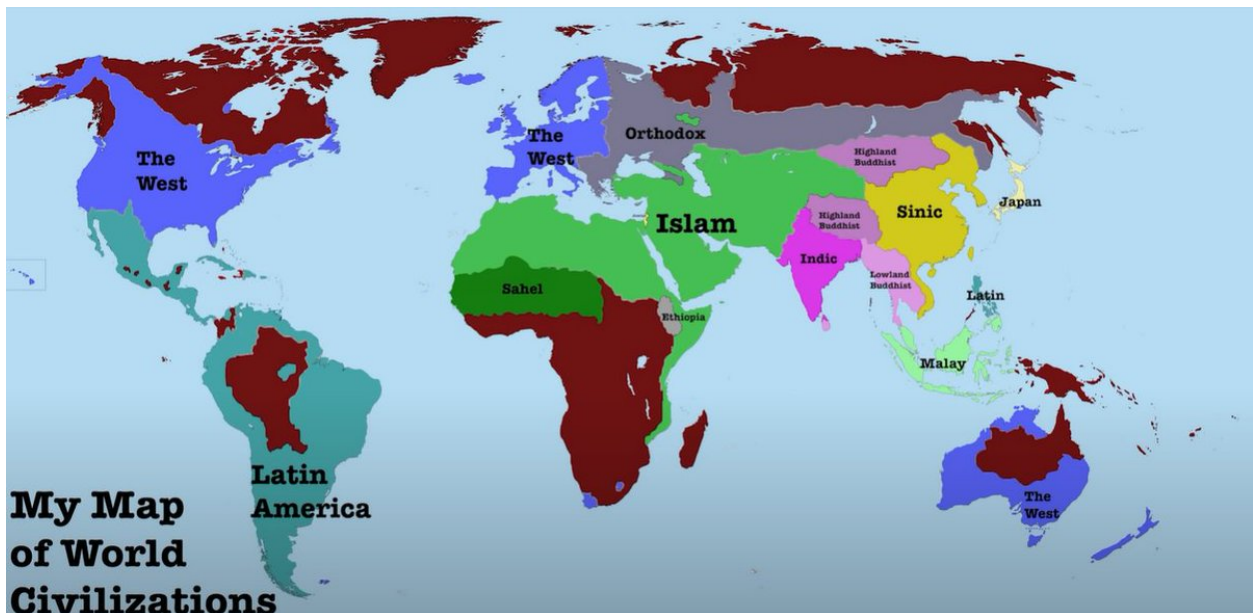
Whatifalthis kicked things off mainly covering alternate history, and to be honest, they really weren't all that bad. I mean sure, he was a bit too anti-communist, which, understandable even if he did take it a bit far, but it really wasn't anything too big. He then began to more slowly pivot into politics, making fairly generic videos about things like 'Why the world is crazy now', with increasingly more and more right wing insanity pouring through. He had a few bad takes about colonialism, american interventionism and the ever so slowly drip of madness that is his grand conspiracy theory of leftist intellectuals supposedly taking over the universities and infecting society with the globohomo.

And then we get to the 'civilisations'. Oh boy, the 'civilisations'.



(yes the maps are not good, get used to them)

He uses a whole bunch of maps, they are often radically different, classifying human society into several distinct 'civilisations'. I have not once been convinced by the line placement, you can always carve out an exception here and there and point out how one thing doesn't belong in the other, which is also why there are several distinct maps floating around.



Now, you can nitpick these maps to death. It is easy to nitpick these maps to death. I'm not going to do it that much (ok a little, it is really really really not good that there are huge sections of the map with billions of people living in it that are blacked out, implying that they are uncivilised), but I think it's far more important to point out that in the end of the day, all of these

'civilisations' have far more in common with each other, especially now, and in the end of the day there aren't really all that many hard lines on a map forcing people into one group or the other.

Just for the sake of the example, try defining something like 'Western Civilisation'. Is Latin America a part of it? Is Eastern Europe a part of it? Is it based on religion, which would put places like Uganda and Angola into the club and Czechia out? Skin color sure as hell is an awful way of determining people groups. It can't be truly based on economics, as I don't think too many would consider a country as plugged into the world financial system as Japan or Korea Western, nor is it based on politics. Maybe it's culture, but that would mean you gotta include some white nationalists running twitter accounts in India or some Bahraini guy who eats too much McDonalds. Simple matter is, at the end of the day, humanity is really one interconnected single civilisation, we are all impacted by each other and we have been this way for thousands of years.

Things like 'Western civilisation' don't really exist, they are just a social construct made up by people to cry about it being under attack. Perhaps it is real in that way in a sort of metaphysical sense, not bound by borders but more of a basic label and identity. And nobody really defines the other 'civilisations'. Maybe there is a vague 'islamic' civilization here and there, but after that the map really does break down. I'm of the personal belief that there is really just one main globe spanning human civilization that has been around for hundreds of years. Maybe people like the Sentinelese aren't part of it (hey, the club is open, sorry about all that stuff).

Whatifalhist doesn't just do this on a worldwide scale, he applies this on a local scale too.





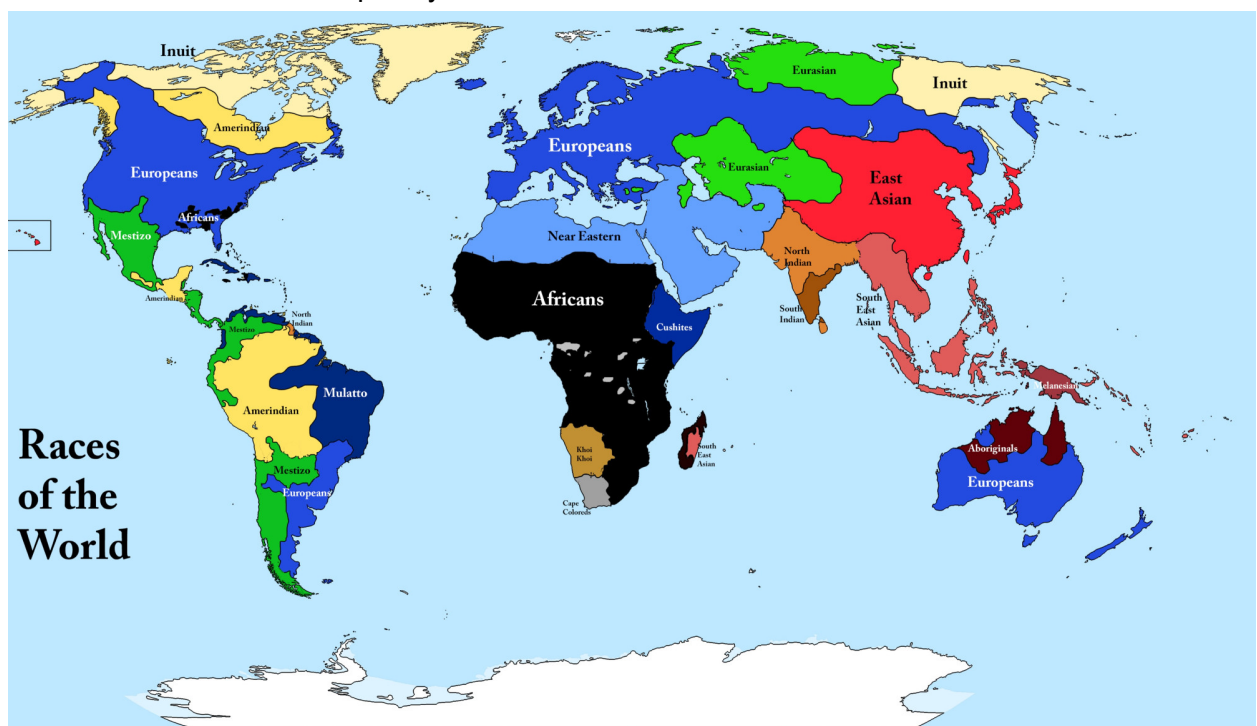

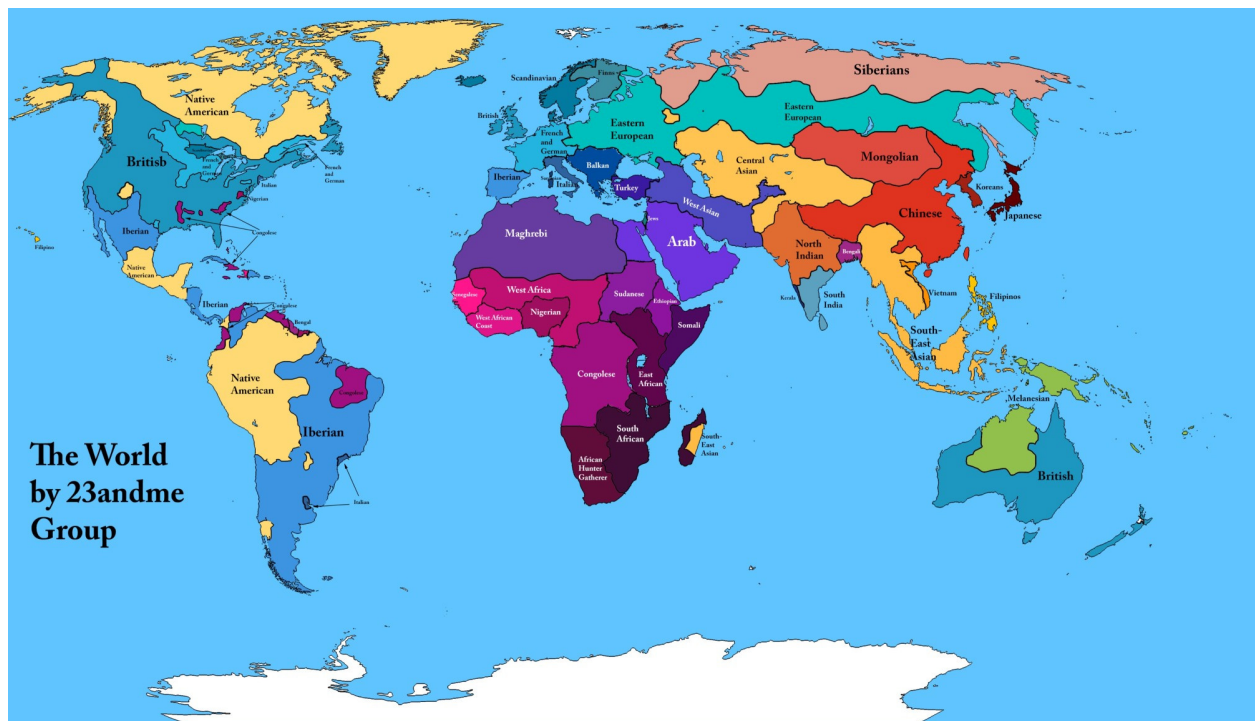
Well, American politics and religious struggles sure are controversial. Let's talk about race science!

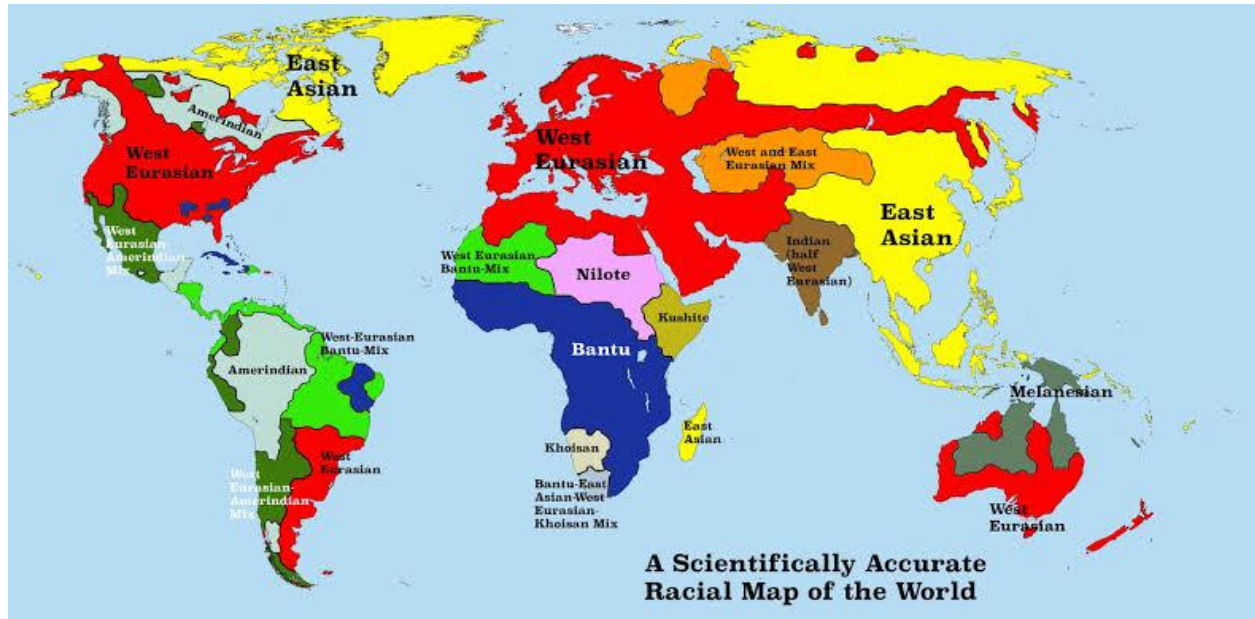
Races of the World

The map illustrates the global distribution of various racial and ethnic groups. Key groups labeled include:

- Inuit** (Yellow): Located in northern Canada and Alaska.

And yeah, each of these are completely different from each other and self contradictory. Yes, the image quality is horrible. No, I do not think there are higher quality images of these available.

But more than anything, the fact that you kinda need to make this is a much bigger cause for concern, like, hold this thought, maybe race isn't a real thing and it's just something people made up to group people together, often for discriminatory reasons? Which also, you know, explains the reason why none of these maps agree with each other nor make sense on their own.

The Maps

Man.

This guy really needs to learn some basic graphics.

See, the map he uses in every single video in the last decade is the Quintessential Base Map, or QBAM. The very map you likely saw before ending up on this badly written manifesto was a QBAM. The map has a low pixel based resolution, which makes it work well if you draw borders pixel by pixel. This is not what Whatifalhist does. Instead, bro just takes a giant pen tool or something and draws a massive, fat line as a border, before filling them in to create his regions or whatever.

Thing is, he also doesn't know what the difference is between aliasing and anti-aliasing, with his filled out regions rapidly switching between the two even on a single map. Sometimes the borders have blurry pixel edges, sometimes they are just straight jagged edges, other times it's a horrific looking blend of the two. He also often makes the maps blurry or incredibly hard to read due to compressing their image files while putting them on videos or uploading them to twitter.

The thing that weirds me out is that he has not changed his map making style in the 10 years he has been making content, with the maps he made as a roughly 14 year old being the exact same stylistically as the ones 10 years later. I have zero idea why he doesn't want to at least correct the basic design mistakes. He claims he has friends in very high places and I know this to be a fact, he regularly discusses being involved with their money and straight up has the world's richest man promoting his content, it really is not hard to get the money to hire a basic editor or something.

The Sources

Wow! That last section was much shorter than the previous one. Will the next one be another long one or just another short blurb barely three paragraphs long?

Let's talk about this guy's funny relationship with sources. From everything I can tell, he has the issue of providing extraordinary claims without extraordinary evidence. Now, I'd be able to take people's word for it when it came to relatively well known topics such as 'A brief history of Ancient Greece' or 'A map of WW1 every day', but brief summaries of the history of the world is not something he provides. Instead, whatifalthis has a habit of making extreme grandiose claims about reality, metaphysics, conspiracy theories about how the leftists run everything and how it's all connected, and his sources are... sometimes nothing.

Well, he eventually started getting backlash for this, so he started to dump out his whole readinglist in the video description. For example, in the video where he claims that the CIA sent thousands of people to the spirit world [17], almost all of modern science is fake, through using some weird methods we can stop parts of our brain from thinking rationally and enter new dimensions of thinking, through things like hypnosis, you can astral project into neighbors house, there is a tiny part of the population who due to genetic ability have vastly superior psychic skills to the rest of the population and that all of these were recently discovered but the media ignored it to focus on Trump and COVID, that small list to his side is all the sources he has. Just a couple books by some crackpots and a few popular books here and there.

I guess if we want to learn how to astrally project into your neighbor's house we gotta start reading some Stephen Hawking.

He gets most of his political worldview from much older works, basing his worldview on people like Oswald Spengler (a guy who literally voted for Hitler), Amory de Riencourt, Carroll Quigley, and other thinkers from the World War era whose theories have been entirely debunked or rendered outdated. He believes our current society has turned stupid and that these older, forgotten authors actually got the truth, unafraid to grapple with the big questions of civilizational destiny, spirituality, and decay. He dismisses modern political science and sociology as sterile, bureaucratic, and trapped within the 'Blue Pill', incapable of seeing the truth [2]. He prefers to pull from these grand, often cyclical theories of history because they agree with his own apocalyptic predictions and his belief that really bad things are going to happen within a few years, which he thinks modern thinkers are too ignorant, stupid or ideologically compliant to confront.



But now what would the bad sources be used for? Well, let's talk about the guy's political views.

The Politics

Over the course of the 2020s, Whatifalhist's content has increasingly gotten more political. Initially just making some vague 'why is everything crazy now' videos, pointing out some obvious things here and there like how the birth rates are collapsing and everyone is addicted to their phones, but it really quickly became complaining about the left whenever he had the chance to do it, I think it started around the video 'Why is America Crazy now?' [3] but there were a few undertones here and there before it kinda escalated to the point where every single video has a good 15 minute long section complaining about leftists in the exact same way as he did before.

“The Left”

His last alternate history video was a ‘what if africa was never colonised’, obviously, by that point he filled up the whole thing with colonialist apologia and then he eventually mostly shifted to making geopolitics videos, just analysing conflicts here and there and projecting wildly into the future. Whatifalthist is OBSESSED with predicting the future, nearly every single one of his videos has a big geopolitical prediction, often with them being exceedingly wild.

The primary focus of Whatifalthist’s content for the past few years has been an attempt to destroy ‘the left’. He defines the left as a single, coherent, ideological project that was created by many groups, including the Jews, Calvinists, Bureaucrats, Women and the French radicals. He claims they are a unified entity, seeking the destruction of traditional western civilisation. Obviously, the idea that the left is a united force is insane. He groups everyone from Joe Biden to Mao Zedong in the same category, ignoring the literal centuries of leftist infighting. Everyone from the CEOs running America’s largest companies to the communist street fighters are part of the left [4].

He claims that leftism was forged from 19th century European thinkers who created a secret intellectual elite to re-engineer society. As industrial civilization expanded, so did the bureaucracy, and they became a hotbed for influence for those thinkers, eventually having their worldview worm their way down society. They captured the universities and then took over all other major institutions from there, including the media, government, law, academia, the school system, religion, major corporations, tech and Hollywood. And of course to bring it in line with most right wing slop, this was enforced by cancel culture. He also apparently believes that “the left” uses the “New Left” (insane radicals) to scare the public, which allows the “Consensus Liberals” (the bureaucracy) to seem moderate as they push society incrementally leftwards.

Needless to say, this is all stuff he made up or regurgitated from equally unhinged authors. He ignores all the dynamics between New Deal Liberalism, Social Democracy, Soviet Communism and corporate globalism in favor of a bizarre, conspiracist narrative of a secret cabal taking over. I mean seriously, how in the world does he believe that megacorporations are controlled by leftists? And of course, he ignores all the genuine struggles so many civil rights movements have had to endure, pinning all progress on some nebulous ‘managerial death cult’.

Whatifalthist also claims that the entire field of modern anthropology is false [5]. He argues that it has abandoned science in favor of a faith-based belief in concepts like the noble savage, equality and the blank slate, while actively suppressing or lying about ‘inconvenient truths’ like the prevalence of tribal warfare, the biological realities of race, and the reasons for global inequality. Obviously, that isn’t true. Modern anthropology has long since moved on from calling people noble savages. The field studies the same big questions Whatifalthist talks about, such as the legacies of colonialism and global economic shifts, but he rejects its conclusions in favor of the more deterministic or culture based explanations he prefers. He also presents long-settled internal debates (like those around Margaret Mead) and misinterpretations of scientific findings as evidence of a giant conspiracy which the left runs. And he obviously wants to replace all of this analysis with his own.

The Motivation

But what is the underlying source behind his political ideology?

- Yes, Whatifalthis is racist, he claims that race is a thing that exists and matters a lot which people have discovered very recently. He claims that because he originally used to state that race and IQ being linked was (correctly) bullshit, but he did a bit of a U-turn on that being in the presence of some real racists like Curt Doolittle and folded on that position. He does at least disavow racial discrimination, so he isn't that bad for now.
- Yes, he is a transphobe, but being a right wing figure that is anti-trans is entirely normal. He believes that the gender binary is a cosmic thing [20] and revolves far too much of his ideology onto it. Whenever he is discussing trans people he posts the same cypypasta with a dozen errors that are factually, logically, and gramatically wrong. Feel free to pick them out!

Why the logical argument for trans makes no sense.

1)The argument is founded upon an idea of gender and sex being different.

This idea isn't falsifiable and no evidence is supplied for why it really exists. It's really a game of defining terms. Things like the nation, love have cultural constructions around them, but that doesn't make the underlying thing fake.

2)Sex is the most important and primal difference in human society. Sex is 2.5 billion years old. Nations are thousands of years, race is hundreds of thousands.

3)There are serious neurological differences between men and women. You can't just ignore that. It's impossible to change that.

4)How does the argument "born in a different body" make any sense. I feel I'm born in the body of a 17th century nobleman. But I'm not. I can't change that.

5)There's the argument that a woman is what we say a woman is. That goes against all theory of language and logic ever. This is a cyclical argument.

6)Falsification is impossible. Ask any activist here what they would need to say to not believe this. They would say by definition its true, but we invented the definition. This means that this is a matter of faith, not rationality

- Yes, he is a bit of an authoritarian claiming to be a libertarian, he'll talk all about leftist totalitarianism but then just casually mention things like 'deporting all immigrants' [22] or 'restoring the patriarchy' [you will see later], something that would obviously need massive amounts of state power to enforce. He also isn't really too much of a fan of democracy, seeing it as a behavioral sink and does tend to admire aristocrats.
- Yes, he is a conspiracy theorist, going at length about the impact of the Frankfurt school and talking about how radical socialist bureaucrats took over the United States and dominated all of society. He quite literally blames the illuminati for this [4]. I have to say, we have a whole lot of billionaires meddling in elections for a communist Society.
- He is a little bit anti-semetic, he does believe that the jews have some secret powers that allowed them to dominate bits of society and he does pin them as one of the key influences of the left [4], but he is at the very least strongly critical of movements that blame the Jews for everything, even expressing admiration for the ability of the Jews to

survive and prosper. His video on 'Jewish Civilisation' [6], is... fascinating:

Includes paid promotion

Examples of Ancient Myths People Doubted but Were True

- 1: Troy.** People didn't think Troy was real until we excavated it in the late 1800s.
- 2: Abraham.** We genetically corroborated there was a shared ancestor in that place and time whom all Abraham's descendents claim ancestry from.
- 3: The Flood Myth.** The Black Sea went from lake to sea in the matter of a week due to the Dardanelles opening up around 5500 BC. The Black Sea was one of the most densely populated places in the world where the survivors fled.
- 4: Trojan Origins.** The Celts and Germans had myths their ancestors came from the Black Sea region, which is genetically true while the Romans said their ancestors came from Troy. The Etruscan genetics are from Anatolia.
- 5: The Garden of Eden.** One of the dominant theories now is that the current human consciousness was developed through mass psychedelic consumption which would have occurred 70,000 years ago when humans learned of abstract concepts like God, life, death, culture etc. It's called the Cognitive Revolution.
- 6: Hindu Mysticism.** Lots of mystic teachings in Hinduism corroborate very closely with modern physics. This includes non local reality, string theory, our neurology effects vision, constant vibration and motion. The universe is truly old and vast.
- 7: Atlantis.** Plato said Atlantis was off the coast of North Africa to the West of the Straights of Gibraltar populated around 10,000 BC. We've found a site called the eye of the Sahara which has a geographic layout like Atlantis is described which was populated at that time and place. The Sahara was wet then.

Explaining Jewish Civilization

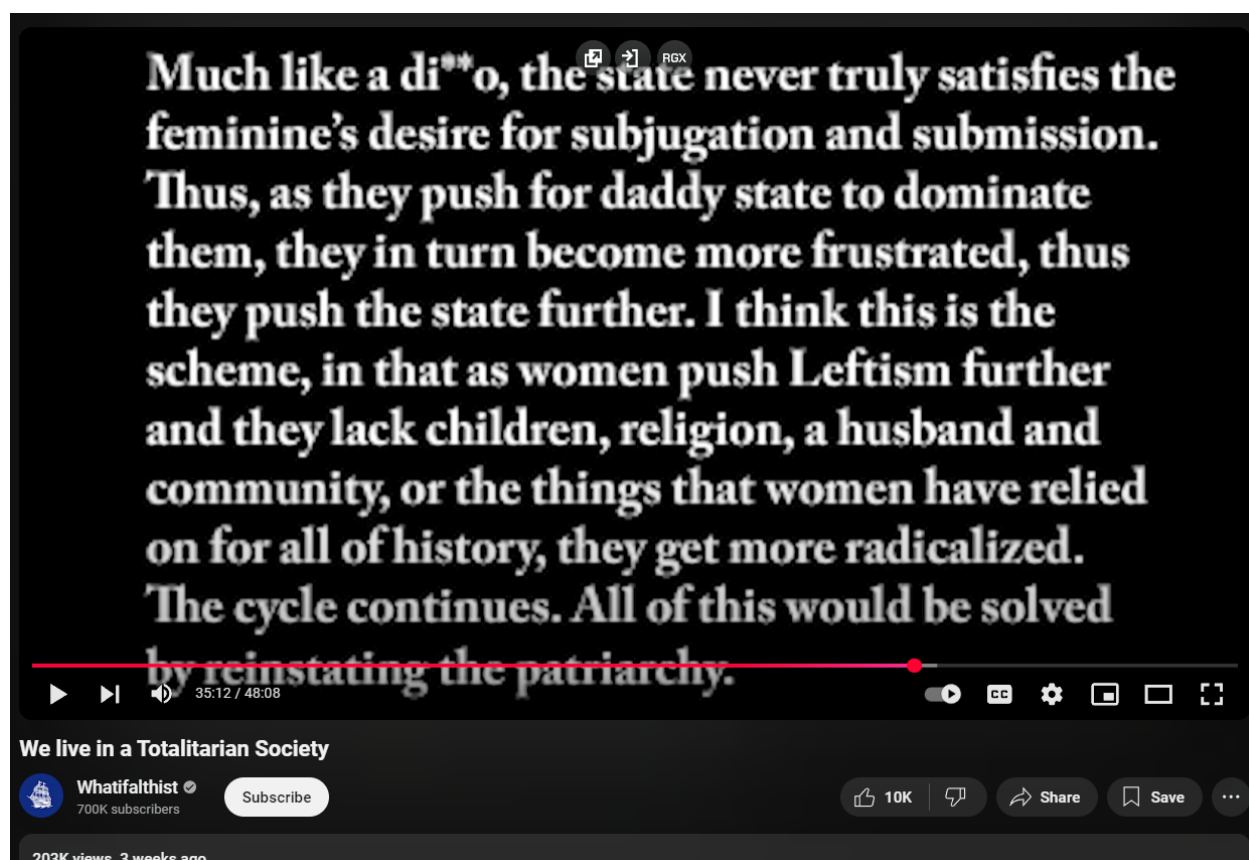

Why Diaspora Jews were effected more so by modernity's psychological Black Death than any other demographic:

1. Very high creativity and intellect which is an opening to mind viruses.
2. Not much emphasis around practicality as a virtue, which is what saved rural America
3. They're incredibly urbanized. I would make this the biggest point.
4. The shift from the ghettos of Eastern Europe to cities occurred within a single generation, which was too rapid to adjust.
5. Their religion was highly autistic and collectivist so they struggled to maintain it outside the ghettos.
6. Horrific cultural PTSD from their history which meant the nihilism hit very quickly.
7. The horrors of the Holocaust destroying their previous strong faith in modernity
8. They universally migrated to Leftist cities and used their schools.
9. These trends did not occur in Israel, which is really insulated which suggests external threats, connection to the land and community is strong

But while all those points are fair, the real source behind his ideology is misogyny. Allow me to present a case.



Honestly, I think that's good enough an argument.

To build off on that, nearly every single video has him angry at something he associates with 'femininity', mentioning things like "society is a competition between Masculine autism and Feminine hysteria". He frames women as irrational, superficial, and driven by base instincts, placing them with heavy blame for destroying society. He associates "feminine" traits (being emotional, nurturing, less competitive) with societal failure and decline, while glorifying "masculine" traits as necessary for strength and progress [7].

He is deeply invested in weird dating culture, arguing that women say they want "nice guys" but are biologically wired to be attracted to "power and aggression". He blames feminism as a destructive force that has broken down families, confused gender roles, and contributed to societal weakness and low birth rates. That is also why an unusual amount of his content is focused around dating and incels, with him mentioning he's close friends with people like Hoe Math (speaking to the heterosexual men in the audience here, if you watch that guy you are as good as done for). He does also seem to have a bad history with women in general.

He blames women for being one of the main sources for the rise of the bureaucracy which he is paranoid about, as well as the decline in the birth rate, the reason why 'western civilisation is committing suicide' and more. It's also why he is transphobic, probably why he is racist and it really just forms the basis of his worldview. He is also paranoid about men being more effeminate and women being more masculine, obviously seeing those as a major reason for the

downfall of society. In one of his videos he was literally fuming at the idea that women like K-pop idols, a direct quote from him being 'this is not a man that could hunt, fish or farm' [8].

There are so, so many more uniquely fascinating and incorrect things I can say about his politics, from his fascination with the unabomber (he has an entire video on this), to him classifying any ideology as a 'religion', his desperate attempts to appeal to incels [13], but for now, it's time to talk about what he thinks will happen to all of us.

The Doom

Around 2020 to 2023 he brought up this one guy called Peter Turchin constantly, he was a guy who allegedly put some variables into a computer and found out that there were civilisational cycles of crisis that happen once every hundred years or so (like the crisis of the 16th century, the Napoleonic Wars, WW1 and of course today) which he has been fear mongering about, claiming that they inevitably point to an impending civilizational collapse and large-scale conflict within the United States, Europe and China in the very near future.

Whatifalthisist bet EVERYTHING on an impending civil war in the US, he made a video saying there is going to be a far right backlash [9], then a video saying America is going to have it's French Revolution [10], and a 30 years war [11], a psychological black death [12], an incel revolution [13], that we are in weimar [14] and that we are in a totalitarian society ourselves [7]. He then did the cardinal sin all doomsday prophets commit, giving a date the world was going to end, by officially declaring that the country will fall into a civil war due to the 2024 election [15].

However, as of today, the 2024 election has unfortunately passed without the predicted civil war. The country did not descend into widespread armed conflict or a revolutionary collapse. It turns out a good chunk of his prophecies were just straight up wrong. Obviously political tensions still exist between the left and right, but it's just that people aren't really motivated enough to wage a civil war, and that more importantly, it would be awful for the economy, which is something that the leadership of both the Democrats and the Republicans absolutely pay attention to.

(Also, by the way, his video on the Incel Revolution got hit by a bogus copyright strike. When he re-uploaded the video, he recorded a 5 minute bit about how the left did this to silence his stupid ass video on incels rising up, before going on with the rest of the video. Then, the copyright claim got resolved, so the video was put back up. But he never really decided to take down the second video, just leaving it up with a 'reuploaded for being too real' label on it [16]. So now there are just two identical Incel Revolution videos, just with the first one having an extra rant debunked by the existence of the previous version. He has left both of them up for over a year now.)

The Silly Mice

And now we get to Mouse Utopia....

He presents this 50-year-old experiment where mice were given a post-scarcity paradise with no predators or disease [8]. Instead of thriving, they fell into a "behavioral sink." The males became the "beautiful ones", effeminate, narcissistic shut-ins who groomed themselves but refused to procreate. The females became aggressive, "masculine" figures who attacked their own young. The society seemingly dissolved into a nihilistic chaos of sterile apathy and purposeless violence, ending in the colony's complete self-extinction. There were even mice going around killing each other. But for Whatifalhist, this was basically exactly what he thought was happening to Western Civilisation right now, from feminism and falling birth rates to modern art and urban life.

One issue, humans aren't mice. We don't live in a utopia where we can just get free food and healthcare, and if we did we'd get envious of those that had better food, clothes and homes and work towards getting it ourselves. In addition, people are not suffering from a "spiritual sickness" born of too much comfort and safety. They are suffering from the very real pressures of a hyper-competitive, globalized, late-stage capitalist system. Young men are not retreating into their bedrooms because life is too easy; they are retreating because the economic ladder has been pulled up, housing is unaffordable, and the stable careers their fathers had have been replaced by a turbulent gig economy. Women are not delaying childbirth because they "loathe procreation"; they are doing so because the cost of raising a child is astronomical and the social support systems for mothers are weak. I know I've been a hypocrite talking about sources, but here's [a Gallup poll showing that Americans do still prefer large family sizes](#) which they haven't been getting.

And this is where his theory goes from a trash analogy into a paranoid fantasy. He needs to account for the most violent, nihilistic mice in the experiment, the "probers" who attacked the last functional members of the colony. So those angry mice going out there killing people are incels or perhaps terrorists, right? Wrong. According to him, the government is going to fill that role, and they are going to go around gunning down families in the name of degrowth ideology. He posits that the state itself, controlled by a suicidal leftist elite, will become the agent of destruction, using its police and military to actively exterminate the sane, procreating Christian families who represent the last hope for civilization.

And now, let's get to the madness.

The Madness

Most people thought Whatifalhist gave up on reality on a level that not even 90% of conservatives have reached in the final week of 2024. I'd argue that happened earlier, with a whole lot of people missing the video 'How the CIA discovered the spirit world' [17]. I'm a bit lazy as of now, so I'm just going to give a non exhaustive list of all the claims in this video:

- The CIA created modern art and modern anthropology.

- They sent thousands of people into the spirit world, something all branches of the US government 'confirmed'.
- This text wall. He posts in almost every single god damn video he makes. Try and point out everything wrong with it!

Examples of motivated pseudo-science in our society:

- 1. There are sizable personality and biological differences between men and women.**
- 2. Biological race is a fact. We find more evidence every year for this.**
- 3. Corn syrup and seed oils drive obesity, not saturated fats.**
- 3. We pushed quantum theory, black holes, and Einstein's theories in physics off some very weak and spotty evidence.**
- 4. We basically invented modern monetary theory with no evidence.**
- 5. We reject the idea that there are lessons to history with no evidence.**
- 6. All the humanities are ideologically motivated, where everything must fit inside a Leftist prism. The humanities assume the Blank Slate, which has been disproven strongly.**
- 7. Almost every trait, including personality and intelligence is half genetic, but our society operates off the Blank slate.**

- Through the gateway project we can stop parts of our brain from thinking rationally and enter new dimensions of thinking, through things like hypnosis.
 - Hindu and Buddhist holy men are better at this than westerners.
 - They managed to map out the whole realm, which is why it vaguely resembles Hindu cosmology.
- Plants can sense emotions from people who are watering them.
- God exists because someone perceived the universe before life existed.
- I'm not even going to put a caption on this:

There are lots of weird details here that they talk about in the report which I don't mention since I don't really know how to explain them and they detract from the main story. One is that we neurologically form a strait line of atoms which allows us to astral project. This is why a strait line, like a wand, are associated with wizards. 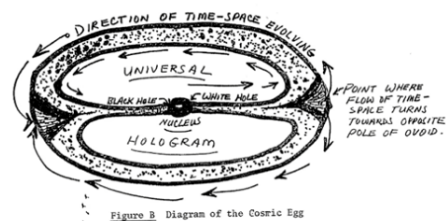


Figure B Diagram of the Cosmic Egg

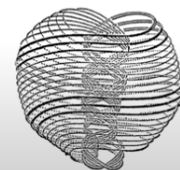


Figure C Stylized Rendition of a Simple Torus

- He says the spirit world is massive, and that people who project from different parts of the spirit world enter different locations in it, that is why religions differ from place to place.
- Quoted verbatim from the transcript: "There are concentric spiritual rings around the earth of higher and higher abstraction, the further you astral project out into the spirit world the more things change from the base reality".
- You can astral project into your neighbor's house or you can go back into the past or into a new planet.
- The CIA used all this research to spy on the Russians. (He is genuinely angry about this because they did not use this research to benefit humanity)
- That Monroe guy could spy on his neighbors and extract information from dead souls.
- There is a tiny part of the population who due to genetic ability have vastly superior psychic skills to the rest of the population.

- The Hindus reached conclusions similar to modern scientists using these spiritual techniques, they had holy men who made a map of the spirit world.
 - There are intelligent beings in the spirit world who communicate telepathically, they found the idea of humans being unable to do this weird.
 - There are monsters in the spirit world that keep possessing humans.
 - They exist in a duality like men and women. (jesus christ this guy is obsessed with the gender binary)

 - We don't have any good explanations for dreaming except for the spirit world.
 - A lot of people used the gateway protocol on their own and they were harmed.
 - All of human history believed in the spirit world except until the last century.
 - The discovery of the spirit world was one of the greatest discoveries in human history and the media covered it up. We drowned out the news of this because of the Trump election and COVID.
 - We will be known as a doomed society that ignores the divine.
 - The government does not want people to know about the spirit world.
 - If things play out good we will have a spiritual revolution, where we as humans can rejoin the divine. (check out the map I made!)

- Not once does Whatifalthis question any of this.
 - As I mentioned before, his sourcing for this is weak. Extraordinary claims need extraordinary evidence. He does not provide this.
 - the top comment of the video was: "he's becoming more unhinged and consequentially, more based"

But to be honest, it really becomes clear why he made that video later on.

He also made this very interesting video called 'Explaining Ancient Forbidden Teachings' [18], where he talks about things like secret societies, medieval heresies and mystery cults linking them to real life organisations such as the World Economic Forum. He points out the fact that most famous scientists that lived over 150 years ago had insane and wild beliefs about reality, and simply goes on about how they were correct about all that. He also dives into alchemy as a legitimate science, talks about Jungian Archetypes as Divine Forces and jumps into outlining the magic world and the way it operates.

Unfortunately, most of the videos he produced alongside these two were just more right wing slop, repeating the same points ad nauseam. ~~Give me more cool stuff man. You once said you were going to make 10 videos on alchemy, where are they? I want to see an in depth map of the spirit world. Show me all the real gods and occult magic you learned. I want to see the goon list~~

~~Odin commanded you to make. I want to see more 'How the CIA found the spirit world' type videos, not more 'Why the left is destroying society' type stuff. Please man, I need to see the mystic shit just for worldbuilding's sake. I know you still want to do it Rudyard. Do not listen to those silicon valley billionaires you are allegedly in contact with who demand more right wing slop.. DO WHAT YOU REALLY WANT TO DO.~~

The Breakdown

After a horrible few months at the end of 2024, Christmas came a day late for the biggest haters of Whatifalthis like myself. A massive, 10 hour long life story and political, philosophical and theological rant in front of a low resolution camera was uploaded to youtube that day [1].

It contained tales of how he was inseminated by his father while his dad had mercury poisoning, stories of trips on Ayahuasca resulting in him being sent to hell and contacting god, genuinely horrific stories of abuse from his mother, visions of the norse god Odin telling him to make goon list, rants on the virtues of masturbation, highly detailed explanations of witchery and wizardry, large sections of Rudyard speaking about himself in the third person, an ungodly amount of rants about women, the construction of his own new theology, another set of rants about the left, plans to create his own 'human capital group' which sounds like a cult and so much hatred for his audience and the world in general.

It would take an entire day to watch his life story, and you could have an hour long discussion about every five minute section. Here are just a few takeaways I have from the video:

- One of the most widely discussed things Rudyard talks about is his memories with his mother. I am not 100% certain these memories are real considering how much stuff he lies about, but they are very clearly affecting him badly. He describes how his mother raped him, beat him, tortured him, starved him and did so much worse, giving him serious PTSD that especially emerged after he took Ayahuasca. He mentions his mother was a schizophrenic, satanic, nazi, leftist literally taking orders by entities to torture him. I have been really frustrated by the fact that this is one of the big things people make fun of him for, considering it is really not something to be taken lightly. He seems to have a more positive view of his father, but to be honest, his father seems abusive in many ways as well, downplaying his PTSD and often siding with his mother in some things. Regardless, Rudyard claims he was brutally abused and was begging to god for it to stop.
- Rudyard seemed to manage to build his own career after growing up, doing things like hiking the Appalachian trail, hanging out with members of the Thiel fellowship in Mexico, and he eventually went to Peru to try out Ayahuasca with the shamans. He claims that 'Ayahuasca basically fried my brain', and this was where things got knocked into high gear. He claimed to be tortured in hell, talk with Satan, and eventually speak with god who he described as a terrifying near lovecraftian entity. God basically commanded him to found a new religion to defend men and defeat the left, and he eventually complied, though he would claim to suffer more than he ever has in his life in the next few months.

He also claims that he rapidly wrote his 'manifesto for the new right' [20] video in an airport hotel, which makes sense considering most of that video is just weird metaphysical concepts.

- Odin. He claims to be in regular contact with the Norse God Odin. He is either a liar, or he has bad, bad schizophrenia, which could make sense as he claims his mother had schizophrenia, an inheritable condition. Odin claimed to heal the intense PTSD he received after taking Ayahuasca by making a list of all the women he masturbated to, perhaps the most famous part of the autobiography. After that, he goes into a fairly long tangent about the virtues of masturbation. He tries very hard to claim that the existence of Odin does not contradict Christianity, trying to reconcile this by claiming Odin is some kind of angel who made his people Nordic convert to the religion. He goes into long tangents, claiming that Odin was the Norse version of the Roman god Mercury/Hermes, and that Odin came into him because he claims his father had crippling Mercury poisoning when inseminated Rudyard's mother.
- The suffering he faced is seen by him as a test, something he had to endure to prepare him to be a messianic figure. He desperately wants all that bad stuff that happened in his life to have some kind of meaning. I understand the sentiment. Without going into too much detail, I am part of a minority group in America that is targeted by the current government and media very hard. Sometimes I feel that this is the fault of the minority group for screwing up, but at the end of the day this is something that would have happened no matter what as they needed power and influence and we were the weakest target. Just like how I sometimes try to rationalise that what is happening to the group I am part of now was the result of some things we did, Rudyard talks about how the suffering he faced had to have meaning in the future, which is why he was destined to be a hero for the new age. But the sad part is, suffering isn't something that makes people good people. It just makes them suffer, and Rudyard has suffered a lot.
- He claims that he oversaturated the alternate history genre by making a lot of scenarios, which is why he quit. No, no he did not. A pretty bad excuse for giving up on a hobby and just only doomposting now. You could have at least given us a "what if the left hadn't taken over every level of society", man.
- There's just too many insane details he claimed in his video. He goes about explaining his bizarre hermeticist theology on how reality works, he has a long elaboration on how magic works, he had long rants about "the great chain of being" and other weird esoteric stuff, he talked about a universal semen existing across all reality, he had multiple mental breakdowns talking about the left, and spent at least a combined total of an hour speaking to himself in the third person, sometimes claiming that he was quite literally possessed by Odin. You can look at the map I made to find a lot, lot more claims like this.
- Perhaps the biggest thing he claims he did in the video was play around with Alchemy (yes, Alchemy is real now, you gotta deal with it) as 'a way to fight the left' and then accidentally make a major breakthrough. He mentioned how he imagined a circle in a triangle, and then apparently this was so big Odin immediately came up to him and said Rudyard did the biggest thing ever, with the Norse god in utter awe of what the former alternate history youtuber had done. Odin said that this shattered 'the psychic shield

wall' that blocked civilisation from being able to access the spirit world. Unfortunately, we as of yet have the ability to communicate with the spirits. Interestingly enough, for the first time at least in my memory, Rudyard actually spoke to 'the left', usually he just talks about leftists. He said that now that he did this act, being left wing doesn't make sense anymore, and that he utterly shattered the left wing worldview. Unfortunately for him, I still think it is important to care about minorities, also I have zero idea what exactly he was getting at.

- One thing I have to point out is that Rudyard has developed a massive, massive ego, claiming he is the person that is destined to save the world. He thinks he is entitled to glory because of the suffering he faced and makes insane claims on how he is a gift from god, saying that he was the one person who ended the intellectual superiority of the left. He refers to himself as 'the God Killer', while claiming he is the absolute master at accessing the spirit world and so much more. His ego gets so big it's genuinely kind of funny.
- This is probably the reason why he found Robert Monroe so compelling, he was one of the few people that had experiences vaguely similar to what Rudyard described.
- One of the most bizarre parts of the whole autobiography was the existence of this organisation known as 'the Order of the Crimson Dragon' (OCD), something that there exists almost no evidence for. From everything I can tell, the OCD is a literal cult masquerading as a 'human capital group' with backing from conservative elites and silicon valley. Rudyard claims 'I want to help your 19 year old son and take responsibility for him.' which to me really seems like he wants to groom people. And it has all the takeaways of a cult, from a doomsday prophecy, to a savior, to a unique belief structure. If he wanted to actually make a cult, it was a stupid idea to do it in the autobiography because it just makes him look unhinged. He could have genuinely succeeded at this if he didn't toss it in with the rest of his meltdown.
- I think he needs help. He should not be making content, or at the very least he should not be taken seriously on any topic.

He then posted a series of famous tweets I'll post down here:

Hi everyone,

I have to tell you folks something. I am a quite advanced mystic and am capable of communicating with the spirit world. If you wonder why I know so much and am so successful at the age of 23, this is part of the reason. I have a photographic memory and have used this to have hundreds of hours of communication with different spiritual forces whether God, the devil, Mother Nature, Hermes Trismegistus, the anima and many more. I have a pretty good map of the spirit world. The Lord God and the tree of life, which is the spirit of consciousness connected to you by blood through evolution, are forcing me against my own consent to intervene in the game now. I really really did not want to do this but God forced my hand. I did this since I was concerned we'd all fucking die as a society if I don't, and I'm young enough I'm invested.

They're really worried about you. They can see inside your souls and know you're all miserable, none of you get laid, have babies or have any reason to live or connection to the divine. It

causes them so much suffering they sent me to say everything is going to be fine and that I'm here to be responsible for my people's survival and their soul. I'm here to explain how both the spirit and material worlds work to you in this stressful juncture in evolution. I serve God and the tree of life. I have 10 hours of video content I've just released explaining what exactly happened to me, what I know of the world and why modernity is all lies.

Everything your era believes are lies. 99% of human history agrees about all this stuff and modern industrial civilization is the one exception. Get with the program, they all venerated the divine, and God doesn't take insults lightly. Your bloodline, God and the spirit world all believe you are completely insane. They see Western civilization is committing suicide and the birth rate is in complete free fall, careening towards zero. They have already won and you haven't realized yet.

I have already established a unified theory of life that incorporates physics, history, every major world religion, biology, Darwinism, Plato and Aristotle. Watch the video if you're interested. Your ancestors were correct and you are wrong. I am a proud Christian and I was very careful that nothing I say contradicts the Bible so this message can elevate Christ. If I ever do, I will immediately submit to scripture. My message can be integrated with any given world religion since I stand for freedom so that we can all experience the spirit world on our own terms. I've been there and I'll show you how. I am a man who stands for other men. I stand so that men will not be treated as cattle.

The meaning of life is empathy. To listen to others and understand them. At the same time to take responsibility for your own actions, to be an adult and accurately assess your environment with self awareness to see what you want yourself. To take your own destiny and follow the path God wants for you. There is no irony or joke here. This is all my best attempt at truth. Look. I'm an empiricist where I just tell you what I read and what I hear from the divine. I challenge anyone to disprove me. I support civil debates to prove me wrong with those who would like to do so. If I'm wrong, I will immediately accept that.

I only have two requests from you. The first is that you should not bother me or my people. Every day I or anyone I'm close to gets personally harassed I refuse to speak to the divine. God and the tree are getting really tired of our society's immaturity and will punish this kind of behavior. I really don't want to bother anyone and I ask the same of you. This is quite stressful for me so I'd like a moment of calm to think. The second is that all debates and conversations I have must be based in logical first principles. No ideology, hysteria and foolishness.

You may wonder who I am to say this. I am Rudyard William Lynch. I'm a 23 year old ethnic Briton from rural Pennsylvania who lives in Texas now. I've hiked the Appalachian trail, ran a club for influencers in Los Angeles and I run a YouTube channel with millions of independent viewers of a month named whatifalhist which talks about history, anthropology, geopolitics and philosophy. I've lived in half a dozen states, countries and worked that many different jobs. I've

read nearly 1000 books so far in my life, and I can draw any country in any year of history from memory on the spot. (Authors note: yeah I probably can do that too it's not that impressive)

I also run an organization called the order of the crimson dragon. We're a human capital group which aims at making men as excellent as possible. We are here to take your son and make him as brave, handsome, smart, charming, skilled and wealthy as possible. I want to help your 19 year old son and take responsibility for him.

The OCD has 70 members with multiple in person locations across the country. We have members in almost every field including several celebrities, people from multiple presidential administrations and genuine intellectuals. We are backed by powerful people in conservative politics, Silicon Valley and media. I will not share their names since I have class and decency. We have an established leadership and internal management structure that I built very carefully. We have teams working on throwing a conference this spring in Austin, a media company, clubhouse, humanities research center and spiritual research. We bring sharp young men together and our goal is to rebuild social institutions around principles of honor, freedom and truth. For those interested we are opening to the public in two months. That's it. It's an honor to serve. I'm here to help as much as I can Best, Rudyard Lynch. (Authors note: Not going to lie, I would be interested in seeing what exactly is going on there, there is zero evidence of any of this so far, I don't live too far from Austin so hit me up Rudy)

Obviously, the backlash to this was immediate. He received scathing criticism from nearly everyone, especially the right wing who saw this as utterly heretical and insane. Judging from his comments on youtube however, there were a few people who still found his video interesting, angry at the 'internet atheists' who shut it down. He tried doubling down on it, but eventually his will would break.

The latest videos I release have attracted lots of negative attention. I understand that. This was a gesture I made given I wanted to make a story as ridiculous as possible as a mirror to demonstrate how silly our society is. We believe stuff as ridiculous as the things I said in this video. Our society is incapable of self regulating our own emotional state. We are incapable of reaching God. We cannot have children. We're completely depressed. I reoriented our spiritual worldview to what 99% of history believed. The things our society believes are completely ridiculous and suicidal. I gave you a mirror to your universe with something equally ridiculous. Reality is a joke. None of you actually know how the universe works. The loss of certainty will feel like opiate withdrawal, It will be excruciatingly painful and I'm sorry.

That being said, I would like us to have debates when the air clears about if anything I said is wrong. I said something deeply ridiculous to move the baseline away from something else deeply ridiculous. My former policy stands. Can you argue me out of anything I said? Can we

please have rational debates about if the things I said are actually wrong stemming from first principles. It should be fun. I challenge you. If I'm a mad man I should be pretty easy to beat. I'll immediately fold if the things I say can't hold up to traditional logical standards.

The Backpedal

He never got the debate he wanted, he immediately folded due to the ridicule, or perhaps influence from his other friends and maybe backers who correctly saw this as a horror they could not tolerate. He pulled down his autobiography, though not before it was archived and made this tweet as an apology.

I was really really stupid here. I was trying to make something go as viral as possible for advertising reasons so I said something as ridiculously over the top as possible as a way to harvest views for my video series and the group.

I was playing some stupid word game about narrativization where I'm technically not saying anything exactly wrong in that you can appoint yourself to serve the tree of life, which means you can say it by definition. I made a whole multi hour segment at the end of the video which was as ridiculous as possible to freak people out on purpose. I talk to a beaver puppet, make jokes about masturbating and talk about the philosophy of magic in it. The point was to show to not take yourself seriously.

I purposely play with the definitions in the video where I say psychic is a person capable of dealing with the realm of forms so "psychic" is one form of intelligence among others that deals with empathic abilities. I basically controlled all the definitions to say this insane thing for clout to harvest for the videos. I did this since it's a Leftist tactic where they control words to get an outcome. Basically, I was playing with the concept of what a social construct is.

Instead this just become a vessel of my own egomania masking under some thin veneer of a joke. I recently had a religious experience which was the best thing that ever happened in my life which kinda drove me crazy. I did recently have a beautiful experience with God which inspired me to go back into politics so I ramped up the insanity to 10. What I did here was an insult to God, but how didn't I see it earlier. I developed some weird rationalization about how misusing God's name would somehow allow me to psy-op the public into believing God through showing Leftism's failures above

Looking back on this I see some part of my shadow that I don't like. Let this be a lesson to you for what to not do. Can you please forgive me for being this stupid? I hope I've built up enough goodwill you can let me be [r-slur]ed.

He immediately dropped a video called 'Shatter the glass of modernity' [19], which was really just basic anti-left slop, and then kinda went dark, just retweeting people celebrating the victory of Trump on twitter and later putting out a few videos here and there. He did his best to try and push this under the rug, but his reputation on the online right would be utterly destroyed, lolcow websites now have long and detailed threads about him and I really can't find a single individual that fully agrees with him on everything anymore.

Rudyard has been desperately trying to rationalise this whole thing. He claims that he was trying to create a 'mirror' to leftist society. On a podcast with Benjamin Boyce [21], he argues that the modern liberal world order is so objectively insane that the only way to demonstrate its absurdity is to create an equally absurd counter-narrative. He says it is a simple reflection to create a counter-narrative that is proportional to how insane the left is. Whatifalthisist claims that him claiming to be a prophet of Odin was just as insane as claiming that "a man can be a woman" and that "the oppressed experiences of reality determine the existence of how the world works". I don't think scientifically agreed views on gender and looking at the world from different perspectives is equal to claiming that "I am literally just like Gandalf" among hundreds of other equally or more insane things.

He also claims that he did this to give his enemies fodder to go clip these things out of context and attack him for only those, which to me seems like an awful strategy because it just makes you look more insane. I'm doing this right now by not only focusing on his autobiography but several other aspects of his worldview. Rudyard also claims he is doing Hegelian dialectics, saying he was trying to merge the 'blue pill thesis' with his 'Odin Stunt antithesis' to produce a new synthesis. Sure.

Now, I don't really believe that he did this as an exercise to prove that the left was insane. He still believes in many crazy topics such as the existence of the spirit world, that alchemy is an accurate framework for describing the world, that ideas are living, sexual entities and obviously everything about modern politics and society that he described in his autobiography. Hell, he even had a discussion about demonic warfare in the medieval world in a podcast with Josh Lustig [22], describing himself sarcastically as a level 12 mage.

He also made it very clear in the autobiography that he was telling the truth about everything. He never once indicated that what he was doing was lying, and if he was trying to make a parody of the left as he claimed earlier, he would probably have announced it before releasing the whole thing. He did claim that the stories of abuse he faced were still real, interestingly enough, and if he was lying I really don't think he would put the two together. I think everything he said in the autobiography is something he genuinely believes or at the very least believed at one point or another. I do think all of this should disqualify people from taking any of his political opinions or really anything he has said seriously, but unlike others I feel he crossed that line a long time ago. A youtuber named Riverboat Jack put it in words I agree with, that criticizing Rudyard is practically ableist at this point, but his beliefs are too harmful to be left unaddressed.

The Pros?

Surprise! A section on the good things, the stuff I liked (or perhaps used to like) about Whatifalthist!

His extremely dense video style isn't everyone's cup of tea, but me, being a person who watches everything on 2x speed because I thought it doubled my productivity, finds it cool. I like his detailed historical analysis, and he used to come to interesting conclusions and make a few points that were worth thinking about. I know he is deeply, deeply knowledgeable about history and historical theory, he really has read a whole lot of books from across history and probably knows a lot more historical facts (even if a lot of them are wrong or outdated) than I know. I'll admit that I haven't really dived all that much into his reading lists and mainly used his videos as a source, but he clearly is exponentially more well read than I am.

He is also very good at communicating history in an easy to digest way. This is one of the biggest issues actually faced by academia, the fact that nobody can really get what they are doing as they trap it in overly complex jargon that's difficult to understand and present. Taking the field of pseudo-archeology as an example, they grew rapidly unchecked because real archeologists didn't have the skill to properly communicate with them, although thankfully this is slowly being reversed with the rise of more genuine content on YouTube. It's the same case with Rudyard and anthropology/big history, with him having a large audience where he can say whatever debunked theories he wishes, without a strong community interested in science communication in that field to counter him.

Hell, if anything, his videos were always at least interesting, even if I always was able to point out something wrong (although this has kind of gone away now that most of his videos are right wing slop). I'm not averse to looking at the world from a right wing perspective that is different from mine, and I think there can be a lot of interesting conclusions made that I would have missed whether I agree or disagree with them. I can't help but draw the line at bigotry though, and sadly Whatifalthist is increasingly addicted to it. Not only would he be better off without it, but his content might actually get better.

The Present

As of now, Whatifalthist is still making videos and pretending that the meltdown never really happened. Most of his videos, including his best performing ones were just slop ranting about the left and how they are going to destroy everything if they aren't stopped, along with a couple videos on the Jews which are not at all popular with the increasingly Hitlerite right wing he's been pandering too. He seems like he has kinda moved past that breakdown he had, but he does also seem to still hold most of the views he presented there, and he sure as hell hasn't changed his mind on any political issues. He still believes we are going to have a civil war soon even after his prediction that it would happen immediately after the 2024 election has utterly failed.

And guess what? It turns out that ELON MUSK, a guy who really needs no introduction, has discovered Whatifalthis and has now been beginning to promote his work, even giving him a follow on twitter (I will deadname the app until he stops deadnaming his daughter). Maybe that solves his financial issues, maybe Elon Musk turns into a devotee of Odin, regardless of the case, I think Whatifalthis is just going to go on and keep existing. If anything, probably not too hard for him to get a nice and comfy career in right wing media, those guys pay pretty well. Maybe he gets an editor that can actually make maps.

A letter to Rudyard Lynch (yes this is corny but I don't care, he does read a whole lot of his critics after all)

I will give you this. If it weren't for your politics, your videos would be interesting, but that's been on a sharp decline as you started to only make right wing slop. I would really be interested in watching a channel like yours that talks about stuff like alternate history, anthropology, different cultures and historical themes that does not spam pics of protests while talking about how stupid people are for worshipping an imaginary totalitarian world order when in reality they are just trying to live their life in a world you correctly point out is messed up. I want to occasionally hear interesting perspectives on people across the world and history without you constantly demeaning other cultures as inferior or complaining about leftists in an overdone way.

You've slotted right into the culture war, becoming a cog in a machine of hatred contributing to so many of the problems you yourself pointed out in many of the videos you made. You have had a lot of bad experiences, some of them which I know have hurt you really bad, and I know it wasn't easy being made fun of in this giant shitpost, but that doesn't excuse you saying some objectively horrible stuff about women, black people, jews, muslims, progressives, union workers, trans people and immigrants.

Please get therapy man, this is coming from someone who needs that advice as much as you do. Ideally I wish you would stop yelling about marxists taking over the universities and controlling the world on top of every single right wing grievance tuned up to eleven, but I understand that's not something that you will do after you read this. And I think you need some really good therapists.

Also please don't curse my bloodline. That would be nice.
