1. **Program Visits:** Attend a KCTC visit and/or KCTC Open house

 - c. **KCTC Programs Open House** - February 4 & 5 from 5pm-7pm
 - i. Located at KCTC Main Campus - open to parents and students

Note: a program visit or attending an open house provides an *improved chance* of getting into the program of your choice.

2. **Enrollment Application Forms:** Enrollment forms are available from February 9-March 11, 2026. The form will be available on Schoology or by scanning the QR code.
 - a. Criminal Justice Students complete both the KCTC Enrollment form and the additional [Criminal Justice](#) Interest Form- due **TBD.**
3. **Pre-enrollment Request Permission:** Once you submit an enrollment request, a **pre-enrollment request permission** form will be emailed to parents from KCTC.
4. **KCTC Decisions**
 - a. Counselors receive KCTC decisions at the beginning of April. Counselors will reach out to students to let them know of their status.
 - b. Enrollment Confirmation and Information will be emailed by KCTC around the end of April. An additional KCTC email will be sent in the summer regarding KCTC orientation information.
 - c. **Late Enrollment.** Enrollment reopens in May for programs that have not filled. Be sure to look for this information during that time. You may still get into a program at this time. There is also a lot of movement and adds/drops throughout the summer so spots do occasionally open if you're on a waitlist. Please let your counselor know if you'd like to drop KCTC or be removed from a waitlist
