## Morris Community High School District 101 ESSER Use of Funds Plan

This is a required posting of the District's plan for its use of ARP-ESSER III funds. This plan will evolve over the next three years as needs and allocations change. Also, some needs may be met wholly or partially with other grant funds. All figures are the best estimates available.

The District has been allocated \$920,480 to be used on eligible expenses between March 13, 2020 and September 30, 2024. The funds must be allocated as follows:

- \$734,046 ESSER III allocation (broad categories of approved uses, but at least 20%, or \$146,809, must be used to address learning loss)
- An additional \$133,542 for learning loss
- \$26,708 reserved for after-school programming
- \$26,708 reserved for summer enrichment
