Stage Crew Job Descriptions

Stage Manager: The Stage Manager is responsible for keeping track of the cast members, sets and miscellaneous details during rehearsals and production of the stage performances as directed by Mrs. Ballard. The Stage Manager will need to attend all rehearsals and stage crew work days if possible.

Set Builders/Stagehands: Under the direction of Mrs. Ballard, design and build all scenery and assemble all scenic elements of the set. Move scenery on and off stage, change backdrops and in charge of lights and curtains during the show. Responsible for the safety of the backstage area during all performances. Cleans stage at start of call-time and is responsible for all set changes during the performances or dress rehearsal. Returns set to “pre-show” setting after every performance.

Costume Crew: Assist Mrs. Ballard with all aspects of costuming the show. This may involve cleaning and organizing in the costume storage area, moving costumes in and out of storage for each show, assisting with distribution of costume pieces and return of costume pieces from the actors. They also ensure that all costume pieces are accounted for and in good working order at the end of each show. Assist actors with any quick changes either on or near the stage and any other costume related needs of the show.

Props Crew: Build, make or acquire any needed props for the production. The Prop Crew is in charge of the prop table(s), making sure it is organized and all props are accounted for and in working order. Must check all props at the beginning of call time and after every performance. Assist with all props during all performances and address any prop problems that might occur. May need to attend rehearsals on Mondays closer to show time.

Pabbie and Bulda, the mystical leaders of the Hidden Folk, remove the ice from Young Anna's head as well as all memories of Young Elsa's magic.
