- I participated in a Zoom call with one of the colleges I'm considering attending in the fall. - This call discussed information about the school in general and also major/program-specific information - Interprofessional Health Science Building is a 30 min drive from the main campus - No housing on IHS campus - For the PA program, must maintain 3.5 science and overall GPA - Also must maintain a “C” or better in all prerequisite courses - 6-year program - Will have to dedicate the majority of time to study - Professors and career center are always available - Need 250 patient care hours - 25 of those hours must be from shadowing a PA - PT aid or CNA are good ways to get hours - Hours can be paid or volunteer - General bio and chem courses will have around 100 students in them, but professors make an effort to get to know you - There are good research opportunities - PA students are chosen first to work at Hackensack Meridian Health Center
