

Campground Rules

- Fire pits are for all, make friends and join one!
- Firewood is for the fire pits, do not take the wood home,
- Fires must be in a designated pit that is provided or a raised enclosed wood fire pit that has a bottom/base and must be on gravel.
- Propane fires need to be on gravel.
- Do not leave food/pet food outside over night; we are in Bear country
- Firearms and fireworks are **not** permitted.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for supervising their children.
- Pets must be leashed at all times and are not permitted in the communal eating area during meals.
- Pet owners are to pick up after pets.
- ATVs should not be traveling more than 15km/hr in the campground, watch out for kids, pets, etc.
- No ATVs allowed in the creek.
- No riding and drinking/drugs; zero tolerance.
- Ensure the campfire is put out.
- Dispose of cigarette butts in garbage, not on the ground.
- No racing on the air strip via a machine. Potato sack races are encouraged though!
- Gate is locked from ~10pm to ~7am each night. If you need access please let us know.
- Quiet time (no generators) is from 11pm to 8am.
- *If you need to run your generator during quiet time for medical purposes let us know prior to parking.
- Recreational use of Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems (RPAS) otherwise known as drones or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs) are not allowed in the provincial parks system
- Check out time: everyone needs to be out by 1pm on Monday. The gate will be locked at 2pm.
- Laughing, smiles, and fun are a must!

Riding Rules

- Riders must abide by all rules as set out by the law.
- All machines must be registered and insured.
- Quad Riders are required to wear a helmet. Side by side riders are ***Strongly Encouraged*** to wear a helmet.
- Riders are required to wear a seat belt in side by sides.
- ATVs should not be traveling more than 15km/hr in the campground, watch out for kids, pets, etc.
 - On the designated trails there is lots of random camping in the area around the trails, ensure to slow down through random camping areas.
- No racing on the air strip via a machine.
- Safe riding: no riding and drinking/drugs whether in campground or outside of.
- Ride with headlights on.
- Ride at the speed you are comfortable at, know your skillset.
- Ride on designated trails only.
- Never ride alone, go out together. Let someone know your riding plan and what time you will be back.
 - Ensure to complete the log book to check in and out at the tent
- Ensure to pack for the weather from clothing to food and water.
 - Do not leave any garbage on the trails; pack out what you pack in.
- Kids under 16 must be with an adult.
- Under 50 cc quads are not allowed on trails. They can be used on the air strip with adult supervision.
- Leave space between riders when ascending or descending some of the larger hills for all riders' safety.
- Club lead rides we will have at least one form of satellite communication in case of emergency.
 - For those of you riding on your own, please discuss who has a communication device within your group in case of an issue. The closest urgent care is in the town of Cochrane, which is south on hwy 40 and then east on hwy 22.
- If you are travelling with a group:
 - At an intersection ensure the person behind you knows which way you are going. Make eye contact and check to ensure they are following you
 - Leave plenty of distance between the person in front of you going up or down a hill.

Any rider driving under the influence (drinking/drugs) will be removed from the event and forfeit monies paid.
