Lesson 1: Happyvism



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Essential question: What makes you happy?

Goal/s	Learners will be able to: Describe 3 personal characteristics and physical attributes that they love most about themselves. Use 3 context clues to analyze visual art and draw conclusions about the author's message of a text. Collaboratively create a Joy anthem that positively celebrates identity (racial/cultural/linguistic/gender expression/orientation/mental & physical ability) through music, metacognition, and social/emotional expression.
