

Breeding Permissions

1. Creating your Entries

First, work on your entries for breeding permission application

Requirements

- **3 different prompts** in total
- **Option 1 - Art:** Fullbody, Colored, Shaded, with Background
Option 2 - Literature: min. 1500 words
- Salikos always have to be at least **50% visible / present** in order to be eligible

Good to know

- You don't have to work on these prompts yourself, they can also be done by other users (both members and non-members of Salikos)
- Please mind that some achievements generally might be earned with lower requirements, but in order to use them for breeding permission, the requirements listed above have to be fulfilled
- For art, you may draw all three prompts in one picture but they have to be clearly distinguishable, f.e. with three separate backgrounds/panels
- For literature, you may have all three chapters in one submission, but each of them have to fulfill the word requirement individually
- You can put as many Salikos in one artwork/literature as you want, but the achievement will only count for a maximum of 3 characters
- You may mix subspecies
- The Salikos may be of the same gender
- It is not necessary to depict the subspecies' natural habitat

Prompts



First Step

You are strong enough to take your first walk.
This usually happens after 3-4 weeks of your life - your main coat is starting to show between the black pelt, eyes are still mostly blue.



First Scuffle

You have been in a 'fight' with your sibling(s) or other whelps.
Should happen within the first year of your life, with another whelp. Main coat is fully shown, eyes are their permanent color.



Stranger

Meeting others of your kind is a big part of life - and an even bigger part when searching for a mate!



Hunting Community

Working together can be vital, especially during hunting. A saliko alone may be small, but when enough get together, they can take down even a great foe!



Struggler

Some meetings don't go well but that's also something we need to learn.



The Bond

You've found a mate to spend time with! Be it for the moment or for life, we will see.



Spring Fever

You've spent...special time together. Somehow. Maybe you've listened to birds singing their love song?



In Vain

Sadly, life isn't just roses and sunshine. Sometimes attraction is a one-sided thing. Whether you're the one getting turned down or rebuffing someone else, it's a lesson either way.



Sweet Home

You made it - you got a den. Well done!



Solidarity

You and your pack will work together to ensure the safety of your offspring, protect your camp, or to achieve a greater goal.



Helping Paw

Someone is hurt and you decide to help. Are you lending them an open ear or do you treat open wounds?



Painful Lesson

Hard lessons are part of a life. You've experienced something bad and have to deal with it - are you wounded or emotionally hurt? Is someone there for you or do you have to deal with it on your own?



Pleasant Anticipation

As female you're getting rounder and rounder and as male your starting to produce milk and get bigger breasts. You can't wait for your whelps!



Babysitter

You'd like to train your parenting skills and offer to take care of someone else's whelps. Or maybe this burden is somehow forced upon you? Whether you want it or not, it's play time now! Better find a way to keep them busy...

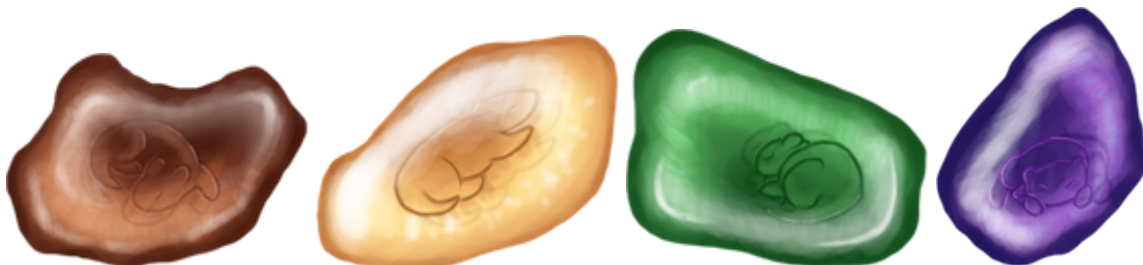
