Haze:	It can't be!?
Panel 3:	Lucidity posing on a gaudy throne, a twisted smile across their face.
Luci:	Oh but it is! And I'm sure you are wondering how I survived?
Luci:	Maybe I didn't? Perhaps I also got blessed with Nine Lives?

Panel 4:	Haze staring forward with a focused and haunted expression.

Panel 3:	Lucidity cockily wiping away the tiniest insignificant drop of blood.

Haze:	You know as well as I do that when I thought I wasn't the clone and then thought I was the clone that actually it turned out I was not the clone the entire time! Your mind games won't work on me!

Panel 4:	[Old timey style hit sound effect]: Tap~
Panel 5:	Pulled back shot of everything destroyed and in ruins, both fighters entirely worn out.
Panel 6:	Haze desperate and pushed to the ledge building emotionally getting ready to call upon his greatest strength.
Haze:	All else has failed to finish things this time... I have to use my ultimate technique to win!
Panel 7:	BG: Haze pulling out a gun and firing it. His expression surprised at Lucidity's counter. FG: Lucidity smugly rattling off references — for a particular goal. Mid-Ground: All the popped up Editor notes blocking the colliding bullet.
