Given the fact that we have limited meeting time, and it does not serve the public interest to have meetings run late into the night, we must limit the time for public comment in meetings, but we always appreciate other methods of communication, such as emails. Regular Board Meetings fall on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of every month unless otherwise noticed. At Regular meetings the public can comment on agenda items or any other matter related to SFUSD (non agenda items). In-person public comment will be prioritized. If time permits virtual public comment may be offered.

The Board of Education is committed to conducting our meetings effectively and in view of the public. Which means they should be held at reasonable and predictable hours. In order to do so, we are committed to completely public comment and beginning to conduct board business no later than 8pm.

Please note, the Board of Education and district staff legally cannot respond to public comment during Board meetings.

Board of Education Commissioners serve in their roles part time, thus it is not always possible to reply to all emails, but Commissioners receive and review all emails.
