The Graf Scholarship committee is composed of five members of the Parish. The committee members will score each application independently before the committee meets to discuss the applications. The committee will then make recommendations for scholarships to the Pastoral Council, which will make the final decisions.

A scholarship is awarded for one year. You may apply for each year you attend Central Catholic High School. All information on this application will be held in the strictest of confidence. Due to the confidential nature of your application, we request that they be delivered to the Parish Office only, and in a **sealed** envelope. You may place the application in the mailbox outside the Kolbe Center at 601 W. Jackson St.
