

VOLUNTARY CLEAN TEEN PROGRAM

Dear Parents/Guardian and Students:

Our vision at Oak View High School is that all students develop and maintain a clean and sober lifestyle. The Clean Teen Program supports this goal through voluntary drug testing, recognition for success, counseling programs and parent involvement. Parent support is essential in the maintenance of a healthy lifestyle for our students.

Prior to each scheduled Clean Teen event, all clean teen members are expected to participate in the voluntary testing procedure. Students can opt out of the testing. Students with a negative result, and those that opted out, may be given a second opportunity to demonstrate a clean test up to one month later, before parents are notified. Clean results are shared with parents. Occasionally, upon the suggestion of school or home, students are tested outside of the regular schedule.

We reward the Clean Teen students with enrichment activities that are outside of the regular school program. Also, we celebrate and acknowledge student success through recognition activities at school. In addition, we support clean teen success through letters of recommendation for part-time employment.

We are available for school-based support and referral information, in cases of negative test results. Students are offered counseling and support group opportunities, both during the school day and after school. A trained professional counselor with Ventura County Health (Success Group), a parent-teen support organization, leads our school-based support group for students.
