

Below are several options for what Circulation could look like for the remainder of Quarter 2. I first worked out options that served all grade levels and both Plan B (In-Person) students AND Virtual Academy (VA) students at the same time. However, after looking at the sheer number of students that would be each week, I can honestly say there is not enough of me as a person to make that work. There remain 2 major differences in the options that remain. 1. Whether I divide up the students into 3 or 5 groups\* for circulation; and, 2. Whether I do Circulation on Fridays or on whatever day students are not in the building. This does NOT take into account when students return books. I would suggest that we set their due date to be the end of the 2nd Quarter. As for how many books a student is able to checkout, Media Services strongly recommends that we lift our limits. I would feel comfortable with up to 5 books per student but am happy to defer to you if you believe it best to be more or less. \*I tried to put them into 4 groups but could not figure out a way to make them more equitable.

**Option A:** This option assumes a two week drive to get currently checked out books returned to school before Circulation begins, that I am in the building on Fridays. If I am in the building on Fridays and it is not an RL day, then I am unable to teach AND do circulation, so Media Specials would need to be asynchronous learning by either pre-recorded lesson, posted learning activity & assignment, or choice board.
