- Your bus ticket receipt/ticket, it should be in your email or on the account you bought it on

- Water bottle
- Change of clothes (You can change clothes at the rest stop if you want)

Currently I'm the main coordinator of the trip. I'm going within the next week or two, to plan a meeting so everyone that is part of our delegation to DC can meet each other and we can discuss our purpose along with our itinerary in Washington. I went on the Women's March trip and National Science March bus and know the routine but making a layout of our trip will be important. I have invited Dayton Indivisible For All (DIFA), Brainstorming for Blue Ohio, The Montgomery County Democratic Party, and The Miami Valley Progressive Caucus to join our trip which will mean more adults will be joining us as well. Also a WHIO reporter might tag along with us, which will be awesome to document our journey! If you have any more questions, don't hesitate to ask.

## TRANSPORTATION/PRICE:

The only charge for this trip is transportation, which will be by a coach charter bus. The price for the bus is \$155 and the price WILL go up March 9th. We are using a company called Rallybus, the same company we used for the Women's March and National Science March. They are very reliable and flexible and we've had great experience with them in the past. Rallybus uses crowdpower to pay for the bus, meaning the bus is not confirmed until every seat is booked on the bus. You will get 100% refund on your ticket if the bus is not filled up, and even after it fills up, you can sell your ticket using their website if you change your mind.
