Edgar R. "Slim" Weiner, 61, Oshkosh, died early Saturday morning in Froedtert Memorial Lutheran Hospital, Wauwatosa.

He was born Sept. 8, 1921, in Oshkosh, the son of Rudolph and Hedwig Fratzke Weiner. He married Lorraine Oaks June 16, 1948, in Oshkosh.
