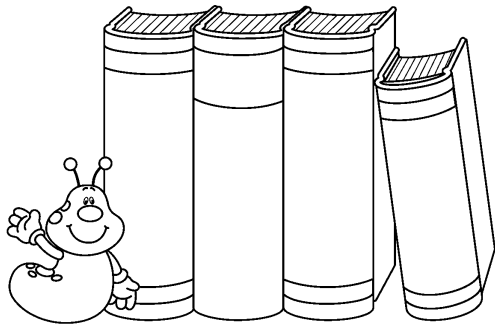

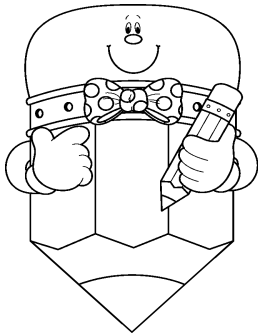
- * All I Am

5 - Go down, around, and a flag up high. That's the way we make a 5.
